## 15D13N BEST OF ITALY

### DAY 1 : KUALA LUMPUR ✈️ ROME

Welcome to ROME! Upon arriving at the airport, we'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

### DAY 2 : ROME



- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided** tour of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo. The tour will end at **Vatican City** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, make your way **to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.



### DAY 3 : ROME



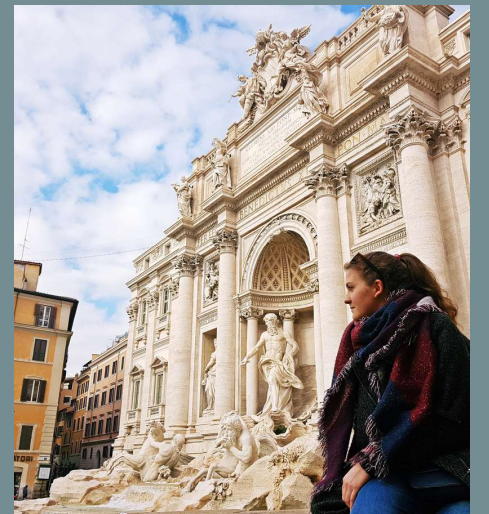
Enjoy a full day of free time to continue exploring the city. Today, we recommend an optional excursion to Naples, Capri, and Pompeii.

### DAY 4 : ROME - ORVIETO - CASTIGLIONE DEL LAGO - SIENA



- Discover beautiful region of Umbria (Orvieto, Siena & Castiglione Del Lago)

Today we'll embark on an enchanting journey through the beautiful region of Umbria. Our first stop will be **Orvieto, a medieval city majestically set atop a flat summit**. Before entering the city, we'll pause to admire the breathtaking views from its viewpoint. We'll then take the **escalators (included) to the medieval center**, where we'll marvel at the cathedral, a stunning masterpiece of Italian Gothic art. The city also boasts a network of underground tunnels, once used as shelters and water reserves during times of war. Next, we'll travel to **Castiglione del Lago, nestled on the banks of Lake Trasimeno**. Here, we'll have time for a leisurely stroll and lunch. After lunch, our journey will continue to **Siena, Tuscany, renowned for its famous Piazza del Campo** and the impressive Duomo. We'll spend the afternoon in Siena.



### DAY 5 : SIENA - MONTERIGGIONI - SAN GIMIGNANO - FLORENCE



- **MONTERIGGIONI**, a magical medieval little village
- **SAN GIMIGNANO**, a charming little city with its tall medieval towers

We'll leave Siena and make a stop at **Monteriggioni**, a magical medieval village with cobbled streets, ancient walls, and quaint little shops. Afterward, we'll continue to **San Gimignano**, a charming little city with tall medieval towers. After lunch, we'll travel to **Florence**, the capital of Tuscany, arriving in the early afternoon. We recommend an afternoon visit to the Uffizi Gallery or the Accademia Gallery (both closed on Mondays). At the end of the day, a traditional local meal will be included.





## DAY 6 : FLORENCE

B

- Florence Walking Tour in historic city centre (Outside views)
- Free time in afternoon in city centre before going to hotel in evening

After capturing a photo at the **Michelangelo viewpoint**, where we'll enjoy one of the most breathtaking views of the city, we'll embark on a **guided tour of the capital of Tuscany**, one of the most visited cities in the country. This city, known as the cradle of the Renaissance, has inspired some of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael. We'll marvel (outside view) at the Gothic Cathedral (Duomo di Firenze), the ancient stone bridge (Ponte Vecchio) with its goldsmith stores, and Piazza della Signoria, the political heart of the city with the town hall in a medieval building. Free time will follow the tour.

**Note:** We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for the city tour in Florence.

## DAY 7 : FLORENCE - PISA - CINQUE TERRE - GENOA

B

- Travel to Pisa & upon arrival take a mini tourist train to Piazza Dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), Photostop at Leaning Tower of Pisa
- Travel to Cinque Terre picturesque Villages

Today, we'll travel to **Pisa**. A **little tourist train** will take us to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), home of the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. After this, we'll head to the Ligurian Riviera, renowned for some of the prettiest coastlines in Europe. We'll visit the **Cinque Terre**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This area comprises five villages, almost isolated by road, which live on fishing and tourism. We'll arrive by train, tickets included, to one of its charming towns (normally **Vernazza**, but on busy tourist dates, it could be Manarola or Corniglia, very similar towns that are somewhat less crowded). We'll have time for lunch. Afterwards, we'll travel by **train** to **Levanto**, where we'll take the bus to continue to **Genoa**. Its center reminds us that it was a thriving republic in the Middle Ages.

**Note:** The train to Cinque Terre is a regular commuter service, not a tourist train. During peak tourism times, there can be long waits as trains may be full, and seat reservations are not available. In some cases, the journey might be done standing. If this happens, we recommend walking to the monumental site, which is approximately 900 meters away.

## DAY 8 : GENOA - PORTOFINO - MILAN

B

- Visit Santa Margherita Ligure & Portofino which is Europe's most exclusive location . Arrival Milan in Late afternoon/evening

We'll continue our journey to the nearby city of **Santa Margherita Ligure**, where we'll embark for **Portofino**, one of the most exclusive places in Europe. Enjoy a stroll by the sea and time at leisure. After lunch, we'll continue to **Milan**, the busy northern city where we recommend a visit to the cathedral.

**Note:** During winter, weather conditions may prevent the boat to Portofino from operating. In such cases, we'll spend more time in Santa Margherita. If you wish, you can take an urban minibus to Portofino (service quality may be poor, with long waits).

## DAY 9 : MILAN - LAKES REGION - VERONA

B

Today we'll see one of the most beautiful scenic areas in Europe, the region of the **Italian Lakes**. First, we'll travel to **Lake Orta** in **Orta San Giulio**, a well-preserved medieval city. We'll take a train ride to reach the medieval center of the town and then a boat to the **Island of San Giulio**, a little island on the lake with a monastery. After this, we'll go on to **Lake Maggiore**, making a stop in **Stresa**, where we'll have the option to visit the Borromean Islands. The highlight is **Isola Bella**, featuring its gardens and palace (closed in the winter). We'll have some time for lunch and then we'll head to **Verona**.





## DAY 10 : VERONA - VENICE



- Travel to Mestre & take Water Taxi Boat trip to Venice Island
- Visit St Mark Square & Murano Glass Workshop
- Gondola optional EUR40/pax

We'll have time to explore **Verona**, the enchanting city of Romeo and Juliet, before departing for **Venice**, arriving around 01:00 p.m. A delightful **boat trip** to St. Mark's Square is included, followed by a **guided walking tour** of the City of Canals, including a visit to see Murano glasswork. Afterwards, enjoy some leisure time—perhaps a optional gondola ride? Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.

## DAY 11 : VENICE - PADUA - SAN MARINO - GUBBIO - PERUGIA



- Visit Padua to explore the Saint's Basilica, then journey to San Marino, a charming mountaintop country. Continue through the Apennines to Gubbio's historic sites before arriving in the enchanting city of Perugia.



We'll embark on our journey to **Padua**, a revered destination for many pilgrims, where we'll visit the magnificent Saint's Basilica. Our adventure will continue to the stunning Adriatic coast, bringing us to **San Marino**, a charming independent country perched atop a fortified mountain. After lunch, we'll traverse the picturesque Apennines, soaking in the breathtaking mountain scenery as we head to **Gubbio**, a beautifully preserved town known for the impressive Palace of Consuls and the 12th-century cathedral. Finally, we'll arrive in the enchanting city of **Perugia**.

## DAY 12 : PERUGIA - ASSISI - ROME - NAPLES



- Explore Perugia, the city of chocolate, with its charming squares and cobblestone streets. Then visit Assisi's Basilica of St. Francis before heading south to Naples, with a possible stop in Rome.



We'll embark on a **panoramic tour** of the historic city of **Perugia**, famously known as the city of chocolate. Ascending to the city on its escalators that traverse the rocky hills, we'll be captivated by its charming squares and cobblestone streets. Afterwards, we'll head to **Assisi**, where we'll have time for lunch and a visit to the Basilica of St. Francis (photostops). In the afternoon, we'll continue our journey south (sometimes stopping in Rome to drop off passengers). We'll arrive in **Naples** in the evening.

## DAY 13 : NAPLES - CAPRI - POMPEII - ROME



- Take a ferry to Capri to explore its natural beauty and enjoy optional visits like the Grotta Bianca or Gardens of Augustus. Return to Naples for lunch, then tour the ancient ruins of Pompeii before continuing to Rome.

We'll take a ferry to **Capri**, and after a 45-minute crossing, we'll arrive on this island, famous for its natural beauty and luxurious lifestyle. If you'd like, you can take a boat to the Grotta Bianca or ride the cable car up to Capri town and visit the Gardens of Augustus for stunning panoramic views. We'll then return to **Naples**, where you'll have time for a walk and lunch. In the afternoon, we'll visit **Pompeii** (admission and guided tour included), the once-thriving city that was buried under ash and rubble when Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD.

We'll continue to **Rome**, arriving at the end of the day.

## DAY 14 : ROME



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
