Day 1 : Depart KLIA

Day 2 : Arrival in Tashkent

 -/-/-

Arrive at **Tashkent International Airport**. Meet your guide and transfer to the hotel. Free time to rest after your flight. Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 3 :Tashkent City Tour – Evening Flight to Bishkek (Kyrgyzstan)

Explore **Tashkent’s** main sights, starting at **Independence Square**, the nation’s symbolic landmark. Stroll along the **local Broadway between Independence Square and Amir Timur Square**. Experience the ornate **Tashkent Metro**, one of the world’s most beautiful underground networks. Visit the **Old City**, including **Chorsu Bazaar**, **Kukaldash Madrasah**, and **Hast Imam Complex** with its historic mosques, madrasahs, and mausoleums. Evening flight to **Bishkek**. Overnight in Bishkek.

Day 4 : Bishkek City Tour

 B/-/-

Discover **Bishkek** with visits to **Pobeda Square (Victory Square)**, **Oak Park**, **Ala-Too Square**, **National Philharmonic**, and other key landmarks. End the day at the bustling **Asian Bazaar**, a vibrant market filled with colorful fabrics, fresh produce, and local life. Overnight in **Bishkek**.

Day 5 : Ala Archa Gorge Excursion

 B/-/-

Travel 45 km south to **Ala Archa National Park**, once reserved for **Soviet VIPs**. Enjoy a light hike to a panoramic viewpoint over the **Tien Shan range**. Return to **Bishkek** to visit the **State Museum of Fine Arts**, showcasing **Kyrgyz** embroidery, felt rugs, and rotating exhibits. Free time for souvenir shopping. Overnight in Bishkek.

Day 6 : Bishkek to Almaty (Kazakhstan)

 B/-/-

Drive approximately 4 hours to **Almaty**, crossing the **Kyrgyz-Kazakh** border en route. Upon arrival, tour the **Green Bazaar**, stroll through **Panfilov Park**, and see the wooden **Zenkov Cathedral**. Ascend **Kok-Tobe Hill** for panoramic city views, then descend via the scenic cable car. Overnight in Almaty.

Day 7 : Day Trip to Charyn Canyon

 B/-/-

Venture into the **Kazakh** countryside to visit **Charyn Canyon**, a natural wonder over 12 million years old. Walk through the striking **Valley of Castles**, where wind and water have sculpted towering sandstone formations resembling ancient fortresses. Along the way, learn about the region’s geology, flora, and Kazakh traditions. Enjoy lunch at a local café before returning to **Almaty** in the late afternoon. Overnight in Almaty.





Day 8 : Flight to Dushanbe (Tajikistan) ✈

🏠 B/-/-

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to **Dushanbe**, the capital of **Tajikistan**. Begin with a stroll through **Rudake Park**, named after the national poet, before visiting **the National Library, White House, and Parliament House**. See the soaring **National Flagpole**, one of the tallest in the world, and visit the **Central Museum** to explore Tajik history and culture. Continue to the **Gurminj Museum of Musical Instruments**, then browse the bustling **Asian Bazaar**. End the day with a traditional Tajik dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Dushanbe.

Day 9 : Iskanderkul Lake

🏠 B/-/-

Travel through the **Fann Mountains** to reach **Iskanderkul Lake (2,255 m)**, named after **Alexander the Great**. En route, cross **the Anzob Pass (3,372 m)** for spectacular views. Stroll along the lakeshore and take a short hike to a nearby waterfall. The serene mountain scenery makes this one of the most beautiful spots in Central Asia. Overnight in a guesthouse near the lake.

Day 10 : Iskanderkul to Penjakent

🏠 B/-/-

Drive to **Penjakent**, a city steeped in history and known as the **“Central Asian Pompeii”**. Visit archaeological ruins dating from the 5th–8th centuries, once a thriving Sogdian cultural and trade hub. Explore remnants of palaces, temples, and workshops, and imagine life here during the height of the **Silk Road**. Overnight in Penjakent.

Day 11 : Penjakent to Samarkand (Uzbekistan)

🏠 B/-/-

Cross the border at **Jartepa into Uzbekistan**. Upon arrival in **Samarkand**, begin your exploration at **Registan Square**, a UNESCO-listed ensemble of three majestic madrasahs. Visit the **Shakhi-Zinda Necropolis**, a stunning avenue of mausoleums, the **Guri Emir Mausoleum**, and the grand **Bibi-Khanum Mosque**. Overnight in Samarkand.

Day 12 : Samarkand to Bukhara (Train)

🏠 B/-/-

Continue exploring **Samarkand** with a visit to the **Ulughbek Observatory**, where 15th-century astronomer **Ulughbek** made significant contributions to science. Browse the vibrant **Siab Bazaar** for spices and sweets, and tour a local carpet factory where skilled women hand-weave intricate designs. In the afternoon, board a train for **Bukhara**. Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 13 : Bukhara City Tour

🏠 B/-/-

Discover **Bukhara’s** treasures, beginning at the ancient **Citadel Ark**, once the residence of the Emirs. See the elegant **Samanid Mausoleum, Chashma Ayub (Job’s Well)**, and the **Bolo-Hauz Mosque** with its forty wooden columns. Stroll through the old trading domes to the **Nodir Divan Begi Madrasah** and **the Lyabi-Hauz Ensemble**. Conclude with **the Poi-Kalon Complex**, featuring the **Kalon Minaret, Mosque, and Mir-Arab Madrasah**. Overnight in Bukhara.

Day 14 : Bukhara Surroundings – Train to Tashkent

🏠 B/-/-

Venture outside the city to the **Bahauddin Naqshbandi Memorial**, an important **Sufi pilgrimage site**, and the summer palace of the **Emirs, Sitorai-Mohi-Hosa**, blending Eastern and Western architectural styles. Return to **Bukhara** for your evening train to Tashkent. Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 15 : Tashkent Tour – Departure

🏠 B/-/-

On your final day, revisit **Independence Square** and **Broadway**, ride the **Tashkent Metro**, and explore **the Old City** one last time. Visit **Hast Imam Complex** to see the revered **Othman Quran**, the world’s oldest known **Quran**, bearing bloodstains from the 8th century. In the evening, transfer to the airport for your departure flight.
