DAY 1 : CHECKIN / DEPART KLIA ✈️ MADRID

- Pickup from airport and transfer to hotel
- In the evening, transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina

Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. Please check the information signs in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide and fellow travelers. In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to **Plaza Mayor** and **La Latina**, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.

DAY 2 : MADRID

- Discover iconic landmarks (photostops) at Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor
- Stroll through Retiro Park, then enjoy free time to explore Madrid

The morning starts with a **comprehensive tour** through the **center of Madrid**, including the **Paseo del Prado**, **Cibeles**, **Neptuno**, **Puerta de Alcalá**, **Plaza de Colón**, and **Plaza Mayor**. Then we will visit **Retiro Park**, an oasis in the city center, where we will see the lake and the **Palacio de Cristal**. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your own leisure. At the end of the evening we will return to the hotel.

DAY 3 : MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA

- Visit the magnificent Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar
- Explore one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries (tickets included). Reach Barcelona in the evening

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, traveling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning **Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar**. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

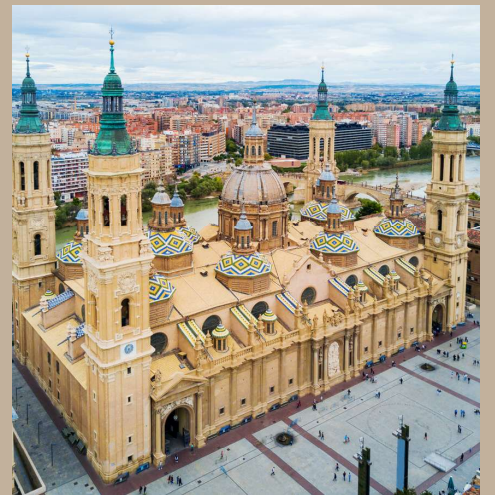
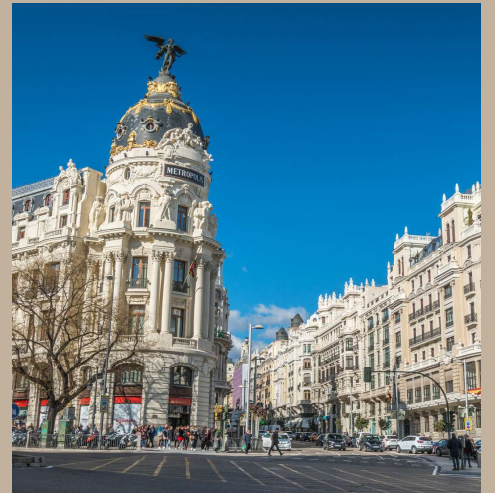
DAY 4 : BARCELONA - GIRONA



B

- Discover Gaudi's architecture, the lively Ramblas & city's rich history.
- Explore Girona's historic center, Jewish quarter, and impressive cathedral (photostops)

In the morning, we'll embark on a **tour of the City of Counts**. This vibrant city, nestled along the Mediterranean Sea, is famous for Gaudi's modernist architecture, the bustling **Rambblas**, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. **Barcelona** is renowned as one of the most beautiful and fascinating European capitals. In the evening, we'll leave Barcelona and travel north into **Catalonia**. Before settling into our hotel, we'll take a walk in **Girona**, exploring its historic center, known for its colorful houses, the old Jewish quarter, and its impressive cathedral.





DAY 5 : GIRONA - CAREERS OF LIGHT - CHAMBERY

- Explore the UNESCO-listed city Arles famous for Roman theatre, and Van Gogh's inspirations.
- Discover the medieval charm of the Savoy capital with its historic old town and castle.

We'll head to **France**, traveling through the **Provence region**. Our first stop will be **Arles**, a small UNESCO World Heritage city known for its connections to Van Gogh. Here, photostops at **Roman theater** and quaint **Romanesque churches**. There will be time to explore and have lunch. Next, we'll include a visit to **Carrières des Lumières**, an incredible underground art experience featuring a captivating display of art, images, and sound in an ancient quarry. We'll arrive in **Chambery**, the charming capital of **Savoy**, for the evening, a medieval style city with beautiful historic center and large castle.

Note: If tickets for the Carrières des Lumières show are unavailable due to high demand, we will provide an alternative visit to the Pont du Gard, a famous Roman aqueduct



DAY 6 : CHAMBERY - GENEVA - GRUYERES - LEYSIN

🏠 B/D

- Switzerland with Lakes and Mountains
- Chocolate factory and dinner included

We'll journey to **Switzerland**, arriving in **Geneva**. With our guide, we'll go to **Palais des Nations** (headquarters of the United Nations in Europe), and we'll see the beautiful **English Garden** with its flower clock, and admire the **Jet d'Eau**, the tallest fountain in Europe. Our next stop will be the charming, walled village of **Gruyères**, world-renowned for its cheese. Nearby, there are some of Switzerland's major chocolate factories, including Nestlé. Our tour includes admission to the **Maison Cailler Chocolate Factory**, where you'll enjoy a sweet tasting experience! We'll continue our journey along scenic roads, passing through bucolic mountain landscapes and picturesque wooden villages, until we reach **Chillon Castle**, built on the shores of **Lake Geneva** (admission included). We'll arrive in **Leysin** by mid-afternoon, a charming holiday village with spectacular views of the **Rhône Valley** and **Mont Blanc**. Leysin is well-known for its winter sports resort and hiking options. Dinner will be included.

Note: Depending on availability, accommodation may sometimes be in another charming Swiss town nestled in the Alps, such as Martigny.



DAY 7 : LEYSIN - INTERLAKEN - LUCERNE - ZURICH

🏠 B

- Cable car ride to GLACIER 3000
- Lunch stop in INTERLAKEN.
- Exploring Lucerne's scenic beauty.

We'll experience stunning mountain scenery today, so be sure to pack your winter clothes. We'll ascend to **Glacier 3000 by cable car ride**, one of the most spectacular spots in Switzerland featuring ice and snow year-round, and where you can walk on the **suspended bridge** between two mountain peaks, explore the **Ice Cathedral**, or enjoy the **Fun Park**. We'll stop in **Interlaken** for lunch before traveling to **Lucerne**, one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. In the evening, we'll arrive in **Zurich**, with some time to explore the center before heading to the hotel.

Note: Occasionally, due to weather conditions such as rain or strong winds, the cable car to Glacier 3000 may not operate.



DAY 8 : ZURICH - STRASBOURG - PARIS

🏠 B

- Explore the charming capital of Alsace, blending French and German influences.
- Travel onward to Paris, reaching in the evening.

We'll depart from Zurich and travel to the French region of **Alsace**, where we'll visit its capital, **Strasbourg**, a charming city that beautifully blends French and German influences. You'll have time to explore and get to know the city. Afterward, we'll continue our journey to **Paris**, arriving in the evening.

DAY 9 : PARIS



- Transfer to Versailles Palace
- Visit Montmartre district
- City tour in Paris

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent **Palace of Versailles** (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



DAY 10 : PARIS - ROUEN



- Visit the 2nd Floor of Eiffel Tower in Paris
- Enjoy a boat cruise along the River Seine
- Free time in afternoon before transfer to Rouen

We'll start our day in **central Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the **second floor** of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. Around 4:00 p.m., we'll depart Paris and head to **Normandy**, arriving in **Rouen**. You'll have free time to explore the historic center of this vibrant city, which dates back to Roman times and boasts charming medieval architecture and an impressive **Gothic cathedral**, offering a delightful blend of history and culture.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.



DAY 11 : ROUEN - ENGLISH CHANNEL - CANTERBURY - LONDON



- Stroll through the historic center of this charming medieval city
- Travel by ferry to Canterbury, the religious capital of England
- Free time at the iconic Tower Bridge before heading to the hotel

Today, we'll have time to take a stroll through the **center of Rouen**. After this, we'll travel to **northern France**. Crossing the **English Channel by ferry**, we'll reach **Canterbury**, the religious capital of England, known for its charming historic center. Our journey will continue to **London**, where you'll have some free time in the **Tower Bridge** area, one of the city's most iconic symbols, before we head to the hotel.



DAY 12 : LONDON



- Explore iconic landmarks like the Parliament, River Thames, and Buckingham Palace (Photostops)
- Afternoon free time or optional Windsor Town EUR40/pax
- Enjoy the vibrant atmosphere of Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho.
- Free time to dine at various restaurants before returning to the hotel.

Discover **London** on a **panoramic tour** with a local guide that showcases the city's culture and history. You'll see famous sites such as the **Parliament**, the **River Thames**, and **Buckingham Palace**, where you might witness the iconic **Changing of the Guard** (depending on the dates). Take a stroll on own through **Leicester Square**, **Chinatown**, and **Soho**, areas renowned for their lively atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment options. You'll have plenty of restaurants to choose from for dinner before we return to the hotel.



DAY 13 : LONDON - KUALA LUMPUR



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
