DAY 1 : Depart Kuala Lumpur

DAY 2 : Arrival Melbourne Airport , SIC Transfer to Hotel

Upon arrival pickup by driver and send to Melbourne hotel (checkin 3pm)

Day 3 : Great Ocean Road Sunset Tour



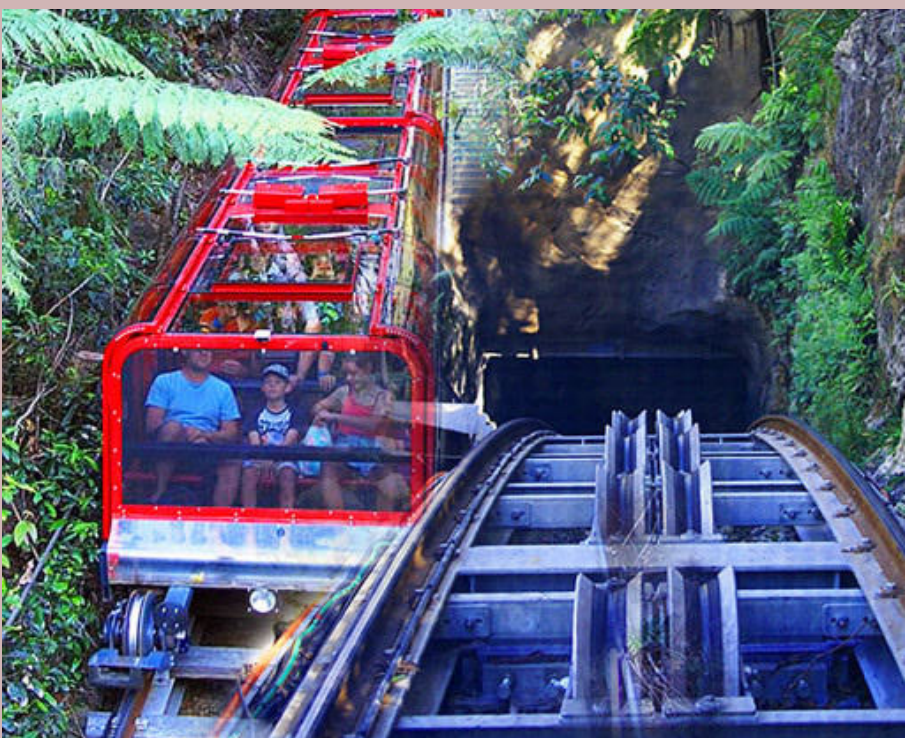
Departing Melbourne at around 10.00 am, we enjoy **panoramic views of the city and Port Phillip Bay as we cross the Westgate Bridge, Australia's longest** at just under 2.6 kilometres in length. We pass by and **learn a little about Victoria's second-largest city, Geelong**, as we make our way towards the Surf Coast, with its **enchanting beachside towns and powerful swells**. We make a brief stop at **the town of Anglesea**, for a chance to **walk alongside the beautiful Anglesea River**, before continuing the scenic journey along the Great Ocean Road.

At the township of Kennett River, we break for lunch (at your own expense) with an opportunity to stroll among the sweetly-scented eucalyptus trees to **locate local koalas in their native habitat**. From here, we travel onwards through the Otway Ranges to the **Shipwreck Coast** and the **iconic rock formations of the Port Campbell National Park**. Our first stop is **Loch Ard Gorge where 52 lives were lost and only 2 souls survived the wreck of the Loch Ard in 1878**. Your guide will recount the legend of the Loch Ard, bringing the gorge to life in a way you never imagined. We take time to explore here, with more rock formations to see, including the **Razorback, the Dumpling Pots and the delightful Island Archway**.

As the sun approaches the horizon, we make our way to our final sightseeing destination. Prepare to be amazed by the **majestic monoliths of the Twelve Apostles**. Enjoy a genuine spectacle watching **the colours of the sky and the land transform in the evening light**. During the day, short stops will be made for lunch and dinner, giving you time to purchase food along the way. Timings and locations may vary depending on the season.

- Visit the beaches of Victoria's famous Surf Coast
- Scenic journey – including photo stops – along the spectacular Great Ocean Road
- Spot wild koalas while strolling in the sweetly-scented eucalyptus forest
- Lunch break (own expense) in one of the Surf Coast's charming townships
- Drive through the towering forests of the Great Otway National Park
- Marvel at the natural beauty of Loch Ard Gorge & hear a famous tale of shipwreck survival
- Spectacular rock formations including the Razorback & the collapsed Island Archway
- Watch the sky's colours change as the sun descends behind the 12 Apostles





Day 4 : Phillip Island Penguin Parade , Brighton Beach & Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife

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Departing Melbourne at around midday 11AM, we journey to the city's most colourful attraction – the **iconic Brighton Beach bathing boxes** – for an opportunity to visit the beach and take some time to admire these historic landmarks. We continue our journey through Melbourne's bayside suburbs **on the way to Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park**. Here, we enjoy a **guided wildlife walk** where we have the opportunity to **meet and hand-feed many species of native Australian animals**. Learn about iconic species such as **kangaroos, koalas, emus, and wallabies**, as well as some of our lesser-known favourites including **quolls, owls, bandicoots, and Tasmanian devils**. Included in our visit here is the spectacular **"Conservation in Action" wildlife show**, which showcases several lesser-known Australian species in a series of **interactive and engaging ranger presentations**.

Continuing to Phillip Island, a **visit to Point Grant and The Nobbies** gives us an opportunity to enjoy views over Westernport Bay and Bass Strait, including **Seal Rocks, home to Australia's largest population of fur seals**. And then it's onwards to the main event, the Phillip Island penguin tour. Just after dark every night, **the world's smallest penguins waddle ashore after spending the day fishing out at sea**. You'll be truly enchanted as the **stars of the show emerge from the surf and pass right before your eyes** on their journey back to their homes. Your guide will ensure you get **the very best vantage point to enjoy the Penguin Parade**.

After the parade, we allow **plenty of time to explore the visitor centre** before beginning our own journey back to Melbourne. With dropoff right back to your inner city accommodation, you'll remember this day as a true highlight of your Australian holiday.

- Visit the famous Brighton Beach boxes for a great photo opportunity
- Enjoy a guided tour at the award-winning Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park
- Meet and feed Australian animals including kangaroos, wallabies and emus
- View and learn about koalas, wombats, dingoes and more
- Visit Point Grant to view the Nobbies and Seal Rocks
- Stroll the coastal boardwalks and enjoy panoramic views
- Watch the penguins waddle ashore at the Phillip Island Penguin Parade at dusk

Day 5: Domestic Flight MEL-SYD , SIC Transfer to Sydney Hotel

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Early morning pickup from Hotel by our driver and transfer to Melbourne airport for domestic flight (included) to Sydney (or vice versa), upon arrival Sydney our driver will pickup from airport and transfer to Sydney hotel (checkin 3pm)

Day 6 : Blue Mountains with entrance to Scenic World

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Journey to the heart of the **Blue Mountains on this full-day tour from Sydney**, including hotel pick-up. Kick-off your adventure seeing a koala or a kangaroo at Wildlife Park, then enjoy a dramatic view of the Three Sisters rocks from Echo Point. After lunch (own expense), head to **Scenic World to ride the Cableway, Skyway and Railway (entrance fee included)** for unbeatable aerial views of the Jamison Valley and Katoomba Falls. Finish with a leisurely cruise along the Parramatta River to Sydney's Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.



- See iconic Australian wildlife including koalas, kangaroos, and native animals.
- Opportunity to take photos with a koala (Admission included)
- Visit the famous Three Sisters rock formation.
- Enjoy panoramic views over the Jamison Valley.
- Learn about the Aboriginal legend behind the Three Sisters.
- Experience the Scenic Railway (world's steepest incline railway)
- Ride the Scenic Cableway with spectacular valley views.
- Walk through the World Heritage rainforest boardwalk.
- View Katoomba Falls, Orphan Rock, Mt Solitary, and the Three Sisters
- Relax on a scenic ferry cruise (**AUD10/pax pay on spot excluded**) from Parramatta River to Darling Harbour or Circular Quay.
- Enjoy Sydney Harbour and waterfront views.
- Once reached **Sydney Central Business District** by ferry you have option to walk to hotel on own or take short uber driver (depending on hotel's location)

Day 7 : Sydney Free Day

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Free at Leisure. Explore Sydney independently and enjoy the city's attractions at your own pace or join any optional tour

Day 8 : Sydney - KL Departure

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Breakfast at hotel, Hotel check-out time 10AM, free at own leisure (can leave bags to hotel's baggage counter if evening flight), pickup by our driver from hotel's lobby and transfer (shared) to airport for flight back to KL
