DAY 1 : KLIA ✈️ ARRIVAL IN FRANKFURT

Welcome To Germany. Upon arrival in Frankfurt, you will be **transferred** to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to relax after your journey or explore the city at your own pace. In the afternoon, you will receive important tour information either directly or via the information board at the hotel reception. **Overnight in Frankfurt**

DAY 2 : FRANKFURT – CRUISE ON THE RHINE – COLOGNE – DORTMUND B

- Scenic Rhine River cruise between Rudesheim and St. Goar
- Explore the picturesque village of Cochem famous for hilltop castle
- Visit Cologne Cathedral, one of Europe's tallest Gothic landmarkst

Today, we'll explore the Rhine and Moselle Valleys, two rivers full of history and dotted with charming villages. We'll begin with a short **cruise on the Rhine**, between the villages of **RÜDESHEIM** and **SANKT GOAR**, undoubtedly the most picturesque section of the river. Next, we'll head to the Moselle River, stopping for lunch in **COCHEM**, a picturesque village on the Rhine riverbank overlooked by its imposing castle, which dates back over a thousand years. Afterward, we'll travel to **COLOGNE**, where you'll have time to visit its impressive Gothic cathedral (photostop). Standing at 154 meters tall, it was the tallest building in the world until the late 19th century. You can also enjoy a walk along the Rhine River and through the lively city center before we continue to our hotel.

Overnight in Dortmund

Note: During fairs or congresses, accommodation may be in Hagen.

DAY 3 : DORTMUND – FAIRY TALE ROUTE – HANNOVER B

- Travel along Germany's Fairy Tale Route inspired by the Brothers Grimm
- Visit Trendelburg Castle and Rapunzel Tower (admission included)
- Explore Corvey Abbey (UNESCO) and Polle (Cinderella Castle ruins)
- Stop in Hamelin, home of the Pied Piper legend, then continue to Hannover

Today, we'll embark on a magical journey, reminiscing about our favorite childhood stories and movies as we travel through the towns that inspired the Brothers Grimm, now known as the **Fairy Tale Route**. Our first stop will be **TRENDELBURG**, a picturesque walled village where we'll **visit the large medieval castle** and its famous Rapunzel Tower (**admission included**). We'll continue along scenic roads, crossing forests that will remind us of the tale of Hansel and Gretel. We'll stop for lunch in **HÖXTER**, a vibrant town where **we'll visit Corvey Abbey**, an ancient 9th-century monastery and World Heritage Site (**admission included**). We'll then stop in **POLLE** to visit the ruins of **Cinderella's Castle (admission included)**. Our journey will continue to **HAMELIN**, renowned for the tale of "The Pied Piper of Hamelin". After following the mouse tracks, we'll proceed to **HANOVER**, where there will be time to take a stroll near the old town hall. **Overnight in Hanover**

Notes: Corvey Abbey is closed from November to February.





DAY 4 : HANNOVER – GOSLAR – BERLIN

 B

- Visit Goslar, a charming medieval town with timber-framed houses
- Explore Quedlinburg (UNESCO), known for its preserved old town
- Free time for strolling and lunch in historic surroundings
- Continue to Berlin, Germany's capital

After breakfast, our route will continue to **GOSLAR**, one of the most beautiful villages in **GERMANY** with wooden architecture, ancient walls, and squares. You'll have time to explore. Next, we proceed to **QUEDLINBURG**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site celebrated for its historic center with over 2,100 half-timbered houses that have remained nearly unscathed for centuries. The town hall and Collegiate Castle are also noteworthy. Enjoy free time for a stroll and lunch. We then continue to **BERLIN**, arriving in the evening. **Overnight in Berlin**

DAY 5 : BERLIN

 B

- Guided panoramic tour of Berlin, Germany's capital
- See Brandenburg Gate, Reichstag & Museum Island
- Visit the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Memorial Museum

Immerse yourself in the local culture with a **guided panoramic tour of BERLIN**, the captivating capital of **GERMANY**. We'll see the historic center, Museum Island, the Reichstag, the Brandenburg Gate, the shopping streets and the city's beautiful parks. Our visit will also include stops at the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Memorial Museum. For an optional excursion, you can visit Potsdam and its stunning palaces. **Overnight in Berlin**

DAY 6 : BERLIN – DRESDEN – PRAGUE

 B

- Travel through scenic forests to Dresden, rich in art and architecture
- Free time to explore Dresden's historic center and palaces
- Continue to Prague, Czech Republic
- Panoramic tour including Prague Castle, Old Town Square & Charles Bridge

We'll travel through scenic forests to **DRESDEN**, a city renowned for its exceptional architectural and artistic heritage, making it one of Germany's top tourist destinations. There will be time to admire its magnificent palaces and enjoy lunch at your leisure. Afterward, we'll cross into the **CZECH REPUBLIC**, arriving in **PRAGUE** in the mid-afternoon. We'll include a **panoramic tour** of this stunning city, where highlights include the Castle, the Town Hall Square, and the iconic Charles Bridge. At the end of the day, the welcoming city center awaits you, home to traditional breweries where you can savor a wide variety of typical beers. **Overnight in Prague**

Note: In some cases, the Prague city tour may take place on Sunday.

DAY 7 : PRAGUE

 B

- Free day to explore Prague at your own pace
- Discover the charming Old Town and historic streets
- Optional tour of Artistic Prague including Mala Strana
- Optional Vltava River cruise and visit to the Jewish Quarter

A free day to explore **PRAGUE** at your own pace. Alternatively, you will have the option to explore Artistic Prague, including Mala Strana, the Infant Jesus of Prague, St. Nicholas Church, a cruise on the Vltava River, and the Jewish Quarter. **Overnight in Prague**

DAY 8 : PRAGUE – LEDNICE – BUDAPEST



- Travel to Lednice (UNESCO) and visit its castle and gardens
- Cross through Slovakia en route to Hungary
- Stop in Győr, the “City of Four Rivers” with time for lunch
- Arrive in Budapest with evening transfer to the pedestrian dining area

We'll depart early from **Prague** and travel to the **Moravia** region, where we'll visit **Lednice**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll have time to explore its beautiful gardens and admire its stunning castle (photostop). Crossing through **Slovakia**, we'll enter **Hungary** and make a stop in **Gyor**, the city of four rivers, where we'll have time for lunch and a leisurely stroll. Our journey will continue to **Budapest**, arriving in the mid-afternoon. In the evening, we'll include a **transfer to the pedestrian area**, where you'll find charming traditional restaurants, many of them featuring live music.

Overnight in Budapest

DAY 9 : BUDAPEST



- Panoramic tour of Budapest, divided by the Danube River
- Discover historic Buda and vibrant Pest districts
- See major landmarks and architectural highlights
- Free afternoon to explore the city

We'll include a **panoramic tour of the city**, divided by the Danube River. We'll visit Buda, with its historic old town, and Pest, known for its lively commercial districts. You'll have the opportunity to experience the charm of this magnificent city. The afternoon will be free for you to explore at your leisure. **Overnight in Budapest**

DAY 10 : BUDAPEST – BRATISLAVA – TRENČIN – KRAKOW



- Travel through Slovakia with a stop in Bratislava
- Explore Bratislava's charming Old Town beneath the castle
- Continue to Trenčín, a medieval town with a hilltop fortress
- Scenic drive to Krakow, Poland

We'll depart early from Budapest and travel through **Slovakia**, where we'll visit **Bratislava**, the country's capital on the banks of the Danube. There will be time for a stroll through its historic center, nestled at the foot of the imposing castle. Our journey will then take us to **Trenčín**, a charming medieval town in western Slovakia, known for its impressive castle and vibrant historic center. There will be time to explore and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we'll continue our route through picturesque landscapes of forests and rolling hills as we make our way to **Poland**. We'll arrive in **Krakow** at the end of the day. **Overnight in Krakow**

DAY 11 : KRAKOW – KALWARIA ZEBRZYDOWSKA – AUSCHWITZ – WARSAW



- Panoramic tour of Krakow including Old Town and photostops Wawel Castle
- Visit Kalwaria Zebrzydowska (UNESCO pilgrimage site)
- Explore Auschwitz-Birkenau, historic concentration camp
- Continue to Warsaw, capital of Poland

In the morning, we will enjoy a **panoramic tour of Kraków** with a local guide. Kraków, the capital of Lesser Poland, was founded in the 7th century, and its Old Town has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. During our visit, we will discover its charming medieval streets, the Main Market Square, one of the largest in Europe, and the heart of the city, and Wawel Castle Hill, the former residence of the Polish kings. After lunch, we will travel to **Kalwaria Zebrzydowska**, a small town set in a beautiful landscape, famous for its complex of monasteries and chapels, and for being a pilgrimage destination and UNESCO World Heritage Site. We will continue toward Auschwitz-Birkenau, the Nazi concentration and extermination camp during World War II, where more than a million people lost their lives. We will visit Camp II-Birkenau, where trains arrived from all over Europe. Arrival at Warsaw at the end of the day. **Overnight in Warsaw**





DAY 12 : WARSAW

- Guided panoramic tour of Warsaw, Poland's capital
- Explore the restored Old Town (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
- Visit Royal Palace, Palace of Culture & Lazienki Park (photostops)
- Free afternoon to explore museums and city center

We'll start the day with a **panoramic tour of WARSAW** with a **local guide**. Home to nearly two million people, this political and economic hub of Poland boasts a blend of modern architecture and meticulously restored historic buildings. We'll stroll through the charming old town, featuring many old buildings, the Royal Palace, and cobble streets, all restored after their destruction in World War II and now declared a World Heritage Site. We'll visit the Palace of Culture, a skyscraper gifted by the Soviet Union, reflect on the history of what was once the largest Jewish ghetto in Europe, and wander through Lazienki Park, home to the Chopin Monument. You'll have free time in the afternoon to visit museums, such as the National Museum and the Warsaw Rising Museum, or to explore the lively city center filled with shops and activities. **Overnight in Warsaw**

DAY 13 : WARSAW ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

🏠 B

- Free time to explore Warsaw (depending on flight schedule)
- Transfer to airport for departure flight
- End of tour in Warsaw

After breakfast, enjoy some free time in Warsaw to relax or explore the city at your own pace. At the designated time, transfer to the airport (**Lotnisko Chopina Warszawa**) for your departure flight. Your journey comes to an end, bringing back wonderful and lasting memories of your European adventure.

DAY 14 : ARRIVAL KUALA LUMPUR
