DAY 1 : CHECK IN / DEPART KLIA ✈️ - ARRIVAL MADRID

Welcome to Madrid! We will take you to the hotel, where you'll have some leisure time to unwind. In the afternoon, you can find details about the beginning of your tour posted on the boards at the hotel reception.

In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina**, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.



DAY 2 : MADRID

🍽️ B

- Morning tour of central Madrid: Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, Plaza Mayor (photostops)
- Explore Retiro Park lake and Palacio de Cristal (photostops)
- Afternoon free time in Madrid or join any optional

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, showcasing attractions such as Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor.

Next, we'll head to Retiro Park, a serene haven in the heart of the city, where we'll visit the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. You'll have the afternoon to explore at your own pace



DAY 3 : MADRID - MERIDA - EVORA - LISBON

- Depart Madrid for Mérida to explore the Roman Theatre and Amphitheatre, a World Heritage Site (Entrance fee included)
- Enjoy lunch (own expenses) in Mérida's historic center.
- Head to Évora, famous for its white streets and Renaissance architecture.
- Arrive in Lisbon by evening.

We'll leave **Madrid**, heading towards the capital of Extremadura: **Mérida**, where we'll visit the archaeological complex of the **Roman Theatre and Amphitheatre** (tickets included), a World Heritage Site renowned for its excellent state of preservation.

There will be time for lunch in the pleasant pedestrian historic center bustling with life and restaurants. We'll continue to Portugal and stop in **Évora**, another city recognized as a World Heritage Site, with its white streets, Renaissance palaces, and cathedral.

We'll arrive in **Lisbon** in the evening.





DAY 4 : LISBON

B

- Discover Lisbon's charming alleys and iconic tiles
- Explore historical Belem, significant for seafaring
- Enjoy free time in Bairro Alto or visit optional Sintra, Cascais, and Estoril
- Return from Restauradores Square, known for lively bars and cafes

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light. We'll also visit the Belem neighborhood, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the Bairro Alto and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an optional trip to the towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively Restauradores Square, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.

DAY 5 : LISBON - FATIMA - PORTO

B

- Visit Fátima, a significant sanctuary in northern Portugal.
- Explore Porto, the country's second-largest city, and enjoy a 50-minute "Rabelo" boat ride on the Douro River.
- Free time is provided after the boat ride.

We'll head to the north of **Portugal** to visit **Fátima**, a revered sanctuary. Our journey will then take us to **Porto**, Portugal's second largest city. After lunch, we'll take a **50-minute boat ride** along the Douro River on a traditional Portuguese "Rabelo" to admire the city from the water. Afterwards, you'll have free time to explore the lively medieval Ribeira district, known for its narrow streets lined with historic merchant houses and charming cafés, before heading to the hotel.



DAY 6 : PORTO - BOM JESUS DO MONTE SANCTUARY - CAMBADOS - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

B

- Ride the historic water-operated cable car to Bom Jesus.
- Enjoy panoramic views and descend the scenic staircase.
- Take a glass-bottom boat trip in Ria de Arousa at Cambados.
- Learn about mussel and oyster production; taste local wine and mussels.
- Explore Santiago's medieval streets and historic sites with a local guide.

Today, we'll travel through stunning landscapes. In **Braga**, we'll take a **ride on the world's oldest water-operated cable car** to reach the **Sanctuary of Bom Jesus**, where breathtaking views await. After exploring the sanctuary, we recommend descending via its picturesque staircase. Our journey continues into Galicia, where we'll visit the historic town of **Cambados** in Rías Baixas. Here, we'll embark on a glass-bottom **boat trip** along the Ria de Arousa, learning about mussel and oyster production. Enjoy **wine and mussel tasting** onboard. At lunchtime, we'll arrive in **Santiago de Compostela** for a **city tour led by a local guide**, exploring its medieval streets and renowned pilgrimage sites dating back to the Middle Ages.



DAY 7 : SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - LUGO - O CEBREIRO - LEON - OVIEDO

- Begin in Lugo to explore the historic town center and Roman walls.
- Visit O Cebreiro, a picturesque stone village in Galicia.
- Have lunch in León and tour the Gothic cathedral and historic center.
- Travel to Asturias, concluding in Oviedo with an evening guided tour.
- Highlights include the 9th-century cathedral, Calatrava Congressional Palace, Campoamor Theatre, and Calle de la Rua (photostops)

We'll travel along the Way of St. James, beginning with **Lugo**. Here, we'll have time to explore the historic town center and its Roman walls, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Next, we'll visit **O Cebreiro**, a charming Galician stone village. Our journey will continue to **León**, where we'll arrive at lunchtime. In **León**, we'll visit the magnificent Gothic cathedral, renowned for its stained-glass windows, and enjoy a stroll through the historic town center. We'll then cross the Cantabrian Range on our way to **Asturias**, arriving in **Oviedo** by evening. We'll include a **tour of the city with a local guide**, either upon arrival or the following morning. During this hour-and-a-half tour, we'll visit the 9th-century cathedral, the Calatrava Congressional Palace, Campoamor Theatre, and Calle de la Rua. Tasting of a typical menu in a cider house in Oviedo.



DAY 8 : OVIEDO - COVADONGA - SANTILLANA DEL MAR - SANTANDER B

- Start at the Basilica of Covadonga in the Picos de Europa
- Explore Santillana for its medieval quarter and the Altamira Cave Museum
- Conclude with a guided tour of Santander city and bay

We'll travel to the **Picos de Europa** (Peaks of Europe). Our journey will begin with a visit to the **Basilica of Covadonga** (photostops). From there, we'll follow the coastline to **Santillana**, one of Spain's most beautiful towns with an intact medieval quarter. We'll also visit the **Altamira Cave Museum** (tickets included), located nearby. Later, we'll head to **Santander**, the capital of the region, a coastal city offering stunning views of both mountains and beaches. A panoramic tour with a local guide is included, allowing us to explore this elegant coastal city and its beautiful bay.



DAY 9 : SANTANDER - BILBAO - FORONDA SERVICE AREA - LA RIOJA - ZARAGOZA B

- Scenic travel along the Cantabrian coast
- Guided tour of Bilbao (Guggenheim, old quarter, Cathedral)
- Free time for authentic "pintxos"
- Explore La Rioja and the Wine Culture Museum in Briones

We'll follow the motorway along the Cantabrian coast, passing through stunning landscapes where mountains meet the sea. Our journey will lead us to **Bilbao**, the largest city in the Basque Country. There, we'll embark on a brief **city tour** with a local guide, exploring highlights such as the Guggenheim area, the old quarter, and the Cathedral (photostops). Following the tour, you'll have free time to savor authentic "pintxos". Later, we'll continue our travels to La Rioja, renowned for its exceptional wines. We'll visit the **Wine Culture Museum** in Briones to delve into the ancient art of winemaking. We'll arrive in **Zaragoza** in the evening.



DAY 10 : ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA B

- Begin with a panoramic tour by a local expert.
- Photostops Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar and Goya's artworks.
- Explore the Roman theatre, Renaissance palace, and Aljafería Palace (Photostops)
- Travel to Poblet Abbey, a scenic medieval monastery (Entrance included)
- End with an evening arrival in Barcelona.

We'll start the day with a **panoramic morning tour of Zaragoza**, led by a local expert. Our first visit will be to the Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll also explore the works of the renowned painter Goya and admire some of his masterpieces. The tour will continue to the Roman theatre and a Renaissance palace, followed by a leisurely walk around the Aljafería Palace. After lunch, we'll travel to Catalonia to explore the beautiful **Poblet Abbey**, a well-preserved medieval monastery set against stunning scenery (tickets included). We'll conclude the day with an evening arrival in **Barcelona**.



DAY 11 : BARCELONA B

- Morning: Panoramic tour of Gaudi's architecture in Barcelona.
- Afternoon: Free time for exploration or join optional tour
- Evening: Dinner and entertainment at Maremagnum near Plaza de Colón.

In the morning, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour of Barcelona**, renowned as one of the most fascinating European capitals. This vibrant city, nestled along the Mediterranean Sea, is famous for Gaudi's modernist architecture, the bustling Ramblas, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. You'll have free time in the afternoon. In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to **Maremagnum**, a contemporary entertainment and dining complex by the sea, located near Plaza de Colón. Here, you can enjoy a leisurely stroll through the lively area and choose from a variety of dining options.





DAY 12 : BARCELONA ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR
