DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️

DAY 2 : MADRID

Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at the airport, we'll be ready to transfer you to your hotel. You'll have some free time until the tour begins. In the evening, we'll provide a **transfer to Plaza Mayor and La Latina**, Madrid's most famous neighborhood for nightlife and tapas restaurants. You can choose to dine at a restaurant of your preference—options include Indian, Chinese, Spanish, and Middle Eastern cuisines.

DAY 3 : MADRID

- Explore Madrid's iconic landmarks, including Plaza Mayor and Retiro Park. (Photo stop)
- Visit Santiago Bernabéu Stadium, and enjoy leisure time in the vibrant city.

The morning will begin with a **comprehensive tour** of central Madrid, featuring highlights like Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, Puerta de Alcalá, Plaza de Colón, and Plaza Mayor. We'll then visit Retiro Park, a beautiful oasis in the city center, where we'll see the lake and the Palacio de Cristal. Admission is included to the **Santiago Bernabéu Stadium**, the home of Real Madrid—considered by many to be the best football club in the world. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your leisure. In the evening, we'll provide a return transfer to the hotel.

DAY 4 : MADRID - ZARAGOZA - POBLET - BARCELONA

- Journey through Castile to Zaragoza's magnificent Cathedral-Basilica,
- Visit the tranquil medieval Poblet Abbey, and arrive in Barcelona by evening.

In the morning, we'll leave for **Aragon**, travelling through the lands of Castile. Our first stop will be in **Zaragoza** to admire the stunning Cathedral-Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar. We'll then journey to the serene **Poblet Abbey**, one of the best-preserved medieval monasteries in the world (tickets included). Finally, we'll head to **Barcelona**, where we'll arrive in the evening.

DAY 5 : BARCELONA

- Explore Barcelona's highlights, including Gaudi's architecture, the Ramblas, and Olympic landmarks. (Photo stop)
- Enjoy free time in the afternoon, and end the day with dining and leisure at Maremagnum by the sea.

In the morning, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour of Barcelona**, renowned as one of the most fascinating European capitals. This vibrant city, nestled along the Mediterranean Sea, is famous for Gaudi's modernist architecture, the bustling Ramblas, and its rich history, highlighted by the Universal Exposition and the Olympics hosted here. You'll have free time in the afternoon. In the evening, we'll provide a transfer to **Maremagnum**, a contemporary entertainment and dining complex by the sea, located near Plaza de Colón. Here, you can enjoy a leisurely stroll through the lively area and choose from a variety of dining options.





DAY 6 : BARCELONA - PARIS



- Enjoy a scenic high-speed train journey from Barcelona to Paris, followed by a convenient transfer to your hotel for a smooth arrival in the City of Light.

At the scheduled time, we'll provide a transfer to the station for your **high-speed train journey from Barcelona to Paris**, which is included in your trip. In just over 6 hours of comfortable travel, you'll arrive at your destination. Upon arrival, another transfer will take you to your hotel. Your guide will contact you in the evening, or you can check the information signs provided at the hotel reception.

Note: The train journey will be without the guide.

DAY 7 : PARIS



- Discover the grandeur of the Palace of Versailles, famed for its opulent halls and landscaped gardens (admission not included)
- Explore Montmartre, the artistic heart of Paris
- Enjoy a panoramic city tour showcasing Paris's iconic landmarks

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **FRANCE** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **PARIS**, we'll visit Montmartre, a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of Paris, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.

DAY 8 : PARIS



- Visit the iconic Eiffel Tower with included access to its second floor.
- Enjoy a serene Seine River cruise, and spend the afternoon exploring Paris at your leisure, back to the hotel on own expenses by taking Uber

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace.

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

DAY 9 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON



- Discover the charming town of Beaune in Burgundy.
- Explore its flower-filled streets and wine heritage.
- Journey to Lyon, where a cable car ride to Notre-Dame de Fourvière offers breathtaking city views, with free time to explore this UNESCO-listed historic center.

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to **Lyon**, the former capital of Roman Gaul, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

Note: In some cases, part of the group will stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the capital de la Savoie, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.

DAY 10 : LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH



- Explore Geneva's iconic landmarks, including the Palace of Nations, the English Garden's flower clock, and the Jet d'Eau. (Photo stop)
- Journey through scenic Swiss landscapes by Lake Geneva and Lake Neuchâtel.
- Visit Neuchâtel for its lake views, historic center, and 10th-century castle, before concluding in Zurich.

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we'll pass by the Palace of Nations (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty English Garden with its flower clock and admire the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe.

After lunch, we'll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We'll drive along the Three Lakes region, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We'll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we'll arrive in the late afternoon.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.



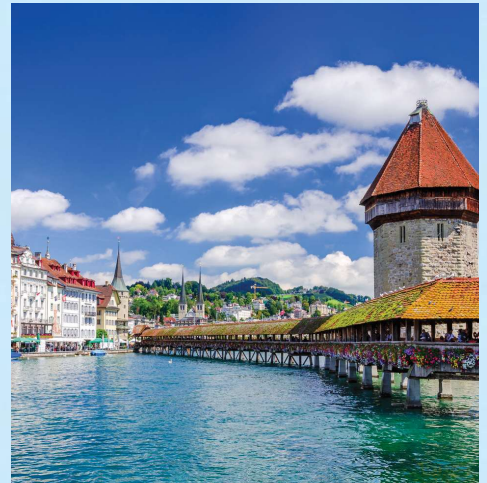
DAY 11 : ZURICH



- Explore Zurich's financial and cultural landmarks.
- Enjoy a scenic two-hour cruise on Lake Zurich with stops at charming villages, including Rapperswil, known for its medieval castle, before returning to Zurich by train.

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

Note: Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via public transport



DAY 12 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH



- Experience breathtaking landscapes in the Interlaken region.
- Visit to Grindelwald, a cable car ride to a mountain with a suspended bridge offering glacier views, followed by lunch on the mountain (included).
- Explore the charming city of Lucerne before returning to Zurich.

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain (included)** before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.



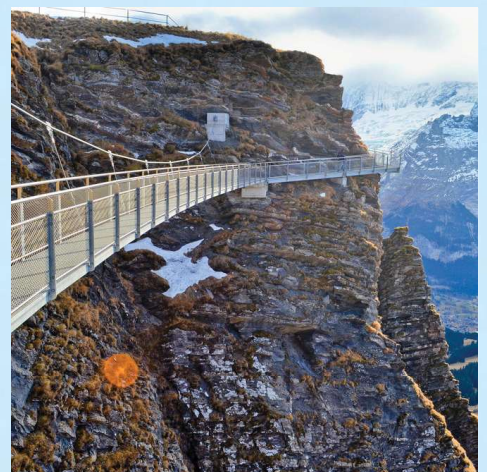
DAY 13 : ZURICH ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR
