DAY 1 : KUALA LUMPUR ✈ LISBON

- Arrival Lisbon , pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel

Welcome to your tour with **Lisbon!** We'll transfer you to the hotel and you'll have some free time. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

DAY 2 : LISBON

🌅 B

- Sightseeing Lisbon's historic streets and Belem neighborhood, celebrating its maritime heritage.
- Enjoy free time in Bairro Alto with an optional excursion to Sintra, Cascais, and Estoril.
- Conclude the day returning via the lively Restauradores Square with its vibrant bars and cafes.

In the morning, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour of Lisbon**, exploring the Portuguese capital of the seven hills, with its charming alleys, iconic tiles, the feeling of "saudade," and the beautiful Atlantic light. We'll also visit the **Belem neighborhood**, from where the great Portuguese navigators set sail to cross the oceans in the 15th century. Free time in the afternoon to walk and go to the **Bairro Alto** and its viewpoint; if you'd like to, you could take an **optional trip** to the towns of Sintra, Cascais and Estoril. In the evening, we'll return to the hotel from the lively **Restauradores Square**, filled with vibrant bars and cafes.



DAY 3 : LISBON - LAGOS - CAPE ST. VINCENT - ALBUFEIRA

🌅 B

- Depart early to enjoy stunning landscapes while crossing the Tagus River
- Explore Lagos' historic port and charming center, then visit Cape St. Vincent and photograph Sagres Fortress
- Unwind in Albufeira—a coastal gem with beautiful beaches and a lively historic center

We'll depart early for **southern Portugal**, enjoying beautiful landscapes as we cross the long bridge over the **Tagus River**.

Upon arrival in the **Algarve**, the southern region of Portugal, we'll explore the historic city of **Lagos**, known for its port from where Portuguese ships once sailed to Brazil, and its charming historic center enclosed within ancient walls.

In the afternoon, we'll travel to the westernmost point of continental Europe amidst windswept cliffs to discover **Cape St. Vincent**. Nearby, we'll have the opportunity to photograph the historic **Sagres fortress**.

Later, we'll spend time in **Albufeira**, a stunning coastal city where you can relax on its beaches or wander through its lively historic center. Accommodation will be provided in Albufeira or a neighboring city in the Algarve.





DAY 4 : ALBUFEIRA - MERTOLA - EVORA

 B

- Enjoy a leisurely walk in Faro, the peaceful Algarve city.
- Visit Mértola in the Alentejo region—a walled town with a notable castle and charming whitewashed streets.
- Explore Évora’s Chapel of Bones and its UNESCO-listed historic center featuring medieval, Gothic, and Roman landmarks.

We’ll travel to **Faro**, the peaceful city of the **Algarve**, for a leisurely stroll. From there, we’ll continue our journey into the **Alentejo region**.

On the banks of the **Guadiana River**, we’ll visit **Mértola**, a walled town-museum, an important center during the Muslim era, dominated by its large castle that invites us to wander through its streets lined with whitewashed houses and historical corners.

We’ll then continue to **Évora**, where we’ll visit the **Chapel of Bones** (admission included), a unique chapel built with more than 5,000 skeletons.

Afterward, we’ll explore this walled city, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, known for its medieval palaces, Gothic religious buildings, and ancient Roman temple.

DAY 5 : EVORA - MARVAO - CASTELO DE VIDE - TOMAR - FATIMA

 B/D

- Travel through Alentejo with stops at Marvão for panoramic views and Castelo de Vide to explore its castle and old Jewish quarter (including a medieval synagogue).
- After lunch, visit Tomar to see the Convent of Christ, a former Templar castle-convent (admission included).
- Stop in Aljustrel to see Lucia’s house, then enjoy free time at the Sanctuary of Fátima with an option for the candlelight procession (dinner included).

Today we’ll travel amidst the beautiful landscapes of **Alentejo**. We’ll stop in **Marvão**, a very picturesque walled town that offers a fantastic panoramic view of the region.

After that, we’ll get to know **Castelo de Vide** with its impressive castle. We’ll also have time to walk through its old Jewish quarter, where we can visit the medieval synagogue (now a museum) or explore the winding streets of the town.

After lunch, we’ll continue to **Tomar**, a city renowned for the Convent of Christ, a former castle-convent that belonged to the **Order of the Templars** (admission included). Before arriving in **Fátima**, we’ll stop in **Aljustrel**, the village where the three young shepherds who witnessed Virgin Mary’s apparitions were born.

We’ll have the opportunity to see **Lucia’s house**. Upon arrival in Fátima, you’ll have free time at the Sanctuary of Fátima, where you can watch the candlelight procession if you wish (not held in winter). Dinner will be included.

DAY 6 : FATIMA - PORTO

 B

- Arrival in Porto, Portugal's second-largest city.
- 50-minute boat ride along Douro River.
- Free time

We’ll travel to the **north of Portugal**. Arriving around 11:00 a.m. in **Porto**, the country’s second-largest city.

We’ll take a **50-minute boat ride along the Douro River** on a traditional Portuguese **"Rabelo"** to admire the city from the water while we drink a delicious Port wine.

Afterwards, you’ll have free time to explore the lively **Ribeira district**, known for its narrow streets lined with historic merchant houses and charming cafés, before heading to the hotel.

DAY 7 : PORTO - BRAGA - BOM JESUS - GUIMARAES - AVEIRO - COIMBRA B/D

- Explore northern Portugal with visits to Braga (religious capital), the Sanctuary of Bom Jesus via the world's oldest funicular, and Guimarães, the first capital of Portugal.
- Discover Aveiro, the "Venice of Portugal," with a Moliceiro boat ride through its canals and a tasting of a local sweet.
- End the day in Coimbra after a journey filled with history, culture, and beautiful landscapes, with dinner included.

Today, we will enjoy beautiful landscapes in **northern Portugal**. We begin with a stroll through **Braga**, the religious capital of **Portugal**, known for its ancient cathedral. Next, we will take the world's oldest funicular up to the **Sanctuary of Bom Jesus**, where magnificent views await. We suggest walking down to admire its impressive baroque stairway. We then continue to **Guimarães**, Portugal's first capital, where the historic **Palace of the Dukes** reflects the city's noble past. After free time for lunch, our journey takes us west to the **Atlantic coast** and to **Aveiro**, the "Venice of Portugal," famous for its colorful houses. Here, we include a charming ride on a traditional **Moliceiro boat** to explore its canals and salt flats, with a tasting of a typical local sweet on board. We then continue to **Coimbra**, arriving in the late afternoon. Dinner will be included.

Note: From November to March, the cruise is not available, so it will be replaced with a scenic drive with stops at viewpoints along the Douro River.

DAY 8: COIMBRA - BATALHA - NAZARE - OBIDOS - LISBON B

- Visit Coimbra to explore its historic university and charming steep streets, then continue to Batalha Monastery, followed by lunch and a stroll in Nazaré with an elevator ride offering ocean views.
- Travel through the picturesque town of Óbidos, renowned for its flower-adorned white streets, and arrive in Lisbon at approximately 07:30 p.m.

We'll spend time in **Coimbra**, the third largest city in Portugal known for its old University and charming, steep streets. Continuing southward, we'll stop at the **Batalha Monastery** (entrance fee included), an impressive medieval mausoleum of kings. There will be time for lunch and a stroll in **Nazaré**, a town of fishermen and a seaside resort. We'll take the **elevator that ascends to the old city** (tickets included), offering impressive views of the ocean. As we travel towards **Lisbon**, we'll make a stop in **Óbidos**, one of the most beautiful towns in Portugal, with its picturesque white streets adorned with flowers. We'll arrive in Lisbon at approximately 07:30 p.m.

DAY 9: LISBON KUALA LUMPUR B

After breakfast, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories.

DAY 10 : ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR

Arrive **Kuala Lumpur**, Welcome Back Home!
