

## 5D4N CAMBODIA (PNH-REP)

### ITINERARY

#### Day 1 : Arrival Phnom Penh - City tour

After arriving at Phnom Penh Airport, you will be greeted by our guide and driver before starting your tour. First, visit the stunning **Royal Palace** complex, home to the Cambodian royal family. Walk through the beautiful royal gardens and explore the **Throne Hall**, where royal ceremonies take place. See the historic **Napoleon III Pavilion** and the famous **Silver Pagoda**, with its floor covered in 5,000 silver tiles. Next, visit the **Independence Monument**, **King Norodom Statue**, **Chaktomuk Riverside** and **NagaWorld**, Cambodia's largest casino, before heading to **Wat Phnom**, a historic pagoda built in 1373 on one of the city's rare hills. End the day with dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

#### Day 2 : Phnom Penh - Siem Reap - City tour

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. At 7:00 AM, we will travel to Siem Reap by bus. Upon arrival, have lunch at a local restaurant before transferring to the hotel for check-in and an overnight stay. In the afternoon, visit the **War Museum** Cambodia, which preserves the history of Cambodia's civil war and showcases a unique collection of wartime artifacts. Afterward, continue to the Chantiers École workshop of **Artisans d'Angkor**, a handicrafts cooperative dedicated to reviving the artisan skills of the Angkor era. Enjoy lunch and dinner at local restaurants. Overnight in Siem Reap.

#### Day 3 : Siem Reap - City Tour - Boat Trip

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. At 8:30 AM, visit the 19th-century temple of **Wat Bo**, one of Siem Reap's most important pagodas. Afterward, explore the vibrant **Old Market** for some shopping before heading to the **Western Baray**, the largest reservoir built during the Khmer Empire. Stretching an impressive 8km in length and 2km in width, this reservoir played a crucial role in the ancient Khmers' advanced hydraulic system, allowing them to manage the seasonal water cycle effectively. In the afternoon, visit the **Floating Village (Tonle Sap)**. Fed by the mighty Mekong and Tonle Sap Rivers, this vast lake is Cambodia's most significant geographical feature. At its center, you will find a sacred alcove where crowds gather around the revered brass and bronze statues of **Preah Ang Chek** and **Ang Chom stood**. Lunch at local restaurant. Dinner at local restaurant. Free at **Pub Street** (Night Market). Overnight in Siem Reap.



## Day 4 : Siem Reap - Angkor Thom - Angkor Wat - Ta Prohm

Breakfast at hotel. At 08:00 AM, we begin our day exploring the immense walled city of **Angkor Thom**, home to the **Terrace of the Leper King, Baphuon, and the iconic Bayon Temple**, a masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. Following the Cham occupation of Angkor from 1177 to 1181, the king built this grand fortress as the heart of his empire. Next, we continue to the temple of **Ta Prohm**, famous for its mystical atmosphere and towering trees entwined with ancient stone this temple was also a filming location for Tomb Raider. As one of the largest temples built during the Khmer Empire, its outer laterite wall stretches an impressive 1,000m by 600m. In the afternoon, we visit the Mother of all temples - **Angkor Wat**. Recognized as the world's largest religious monument, this architectural wonder is a perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry, serving as a source of pride and strength for all Khmers. Finally, we end the day with a breathtaking sunset view from **Bakheng Mountain**. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, followed by dinner at a local restaurant, and conclude the day with an overnight stay in Siem Reap.

(Note: Due to new regulations, only 300 visitors are allowed to ascend Bakheng Hill at a time, so we must arrive by 4:00 PM.)

## Day 5 : Siem Reap Departure
