DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ PRAGUE

Welcome to **Prague**! Upon arriving at the airport, we'll **transfer you to your hotel**. Check the information boards in the hotel reception area for details about the welcome meeting with your guide. In the evening, we'll **transfer you to the Old Town Square**, a lively area bustling with tourist activity. You can enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants offering a variety of international cuisines, including Czech, Chinese, Indian, and Italian. Afterward, there will be a return transfer to the hotel.

DAY 2 : PRAGUE



- Experience the best of Prague, the Baroque jewel of Europe)
- Begin with a guided city tour featuring iconic landmarks and a visit to the majestic Prague Castle (admission included).
- Enjoy a picturesque boat tour on the Vltava River, followed by free time to explore the city's historic charm.



Today, we'll visit the capital, **Prague**, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an informative **panoramic tour**, highlighting the city's most outstanding monuments. During the tour, there will be a visit to **Prague Castle** (admission included). After that, enjoy a **boat ride on the Vltava River** (included). In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore the city on your own.



DAY 3 : PRAGUE - MUNICH - INNSBRUCK



- Journey from Bavaria to the Alps with a day full of highlights. Begin in Munich, exploring its historic city center.
- Travel to Innsbruck, the capital of Tyrol, where you'll explore the charming Old Town and Golden Roof area

We'll depart early and head to Bavaria, **Germany**. We'll arrive in **Munich** by midday, where you'll have free time to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we'll continue to **Austria**. Upon arrival in the heart of the Alps, you'll have time to explore **Innsbruck**, the capital of Tyrol. There will be time for dinner in the Golden Roof area and Old Town.



DAY 4 : INNSBRUCK - ZURICH



- Visit to Swarovski Museum (Entrance ticket included)
- Explore Swarovski Museum's gardens and learn about crystal creation process.
- Enjoy Tyrolean scenery along the way.

Start your day with a visit to the **Swarovski Museum**, the famous home of crystals. We'll explore its impressive gardens and learn about the creation process behind the stunning Swarovski pieces. Afterward, enjoy some free time to stroll around before we head to Zurich, enjoying the beautiful Tyrolean scenery along the way. In Zurich, spend the evening in the historic center by the lake, where you can choose from a variety of restaurants offering Indian, Oriental, Italian, International, and Swiss cuisine.





DAY 5 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

- Admire the fantastic landscapes of Switzerland on the way to Grindelwald
- Cable car included to Grindelwald first
- Simple Lunch included on the Mountain Top
- Back to Lucerne , have some free time before going back to Zurich hotel

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers.

We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.

DAY 6 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN

- Explore Bellinzona famous for Medieval Castles & Charming town of Como
- Enjoy free time in the Milan's city center

We'll leave **Zurich** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **Bellinzona**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center.

Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **Como** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **Lombardy**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo area. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.

DAY 7 : MILAN - PISA - ROME

- We will travel beautiful Coast of Liguria on the way to Pisa
- Little Tourist mini train in Pisa & View of Leaning Tower of Pisa (Photostop)

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.

DAY 8 : ROME



- Guided tour: Colosseum (exterior), Imperial Forums, Circus Maximus
- Optional Vatican Museums & Sistine Chapel visit
- Dinner & free time in Trastevere

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo.

The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel.

At the end of the day, we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

DAY 9 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Enjoying stunning landscapes on journey to Florence
- Arrival at Piazzale Michelangelo for stunning city views
- Guided walking tour through historic center, visiting landmarks like Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria (Photostops)

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.

DAY 10 : FLORENCE - VENICE



- Stunning Mountain landscapes enroute to Venice, We will take Water Taxi to reach Venice Island from Mestre
- Visit St. Mark's Square with a local guide.
- Tour the Murano Glass Factory to learn ancient glass techniques.

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district. (Gondola ride optional EUR40/pax)

DAY 11 : VENICE - INNSBRUCK - SALZBURG



- Journey through scenic mountains to Kitzbühel.
- Explore Kitzbühel, a picturesque Ski Town. Proceed to Salzburg

We will depart from **Venice**, traveling to **Austria**! Upon arriving in **Innsbruck**, you'll have time to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy lunch in the Austrian Tyrolean capital. Afterward, we'll journey along beautiful scenic roads through the mountains to **Kitzbühel**. Once there, you'll have time to explore this picturesque village, a famous ski resort where snow can be enjoyed for most of the year. We'll continue our journey to **Salzburg**, arriving by the end of the day.

Note: If there are few travelers, we may take a train from Venice to Innsbruck.



DAY 12 : SALZBURG - LAKE TRAUNSEE - VIENNA



- Discover Salzburg's Renaissance and Baroque architecture near the castle.
- Travel through scenic lakes and mountains to St. Wolfgang, a major pilgrimage site & Explore Traunkirchen by Traunsee Lake, including a cruise to see four castles.

Today, we'll get to know **Austria** better. During the morning, we'll explore **Salzburg**, Mozart's city. Its Renaissance and Baroque center is filled with beauty, all in the shadow of the grand castle. Next, we'll travel through lakes and mountains to reach **St. Wolfgang**, a renowned pilgrimage site in **Austria**. We'll then head to **Traunkirchen**, located beside the beautiful **Traunsee Lake**, where we'll take an included **cruise** to see four of the lake's castles before disembarking in **Gmunden**. Afterward, we'll continue to **Vienna**, arriving in the evening.



DAY 13 : VIENNA



- Explores city's majestic avenues, palaces, parks, and city center (Photostops)
- Allows free time for exploration in afternoon
- Transfer to Grinzing district, an old wine-growing village with traditional taverns.

Today, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour** of this impressive city with a local guide. We'll explore its majestic avenues, beautiful palaces, large parks and vibrant city center. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore on your own. In the evening, we'll include a **transfer to the Grinzing district**, an old wine-growing village now part of the city, known for its traditional taverns. You'll have free time to dine in the area.



DAY 14 : VIENNA ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR



After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.



DAY 15 : ARRIVE KUALA LUMPUR
