DAY 01: DEPART KLIA/ARRIVAL ROME

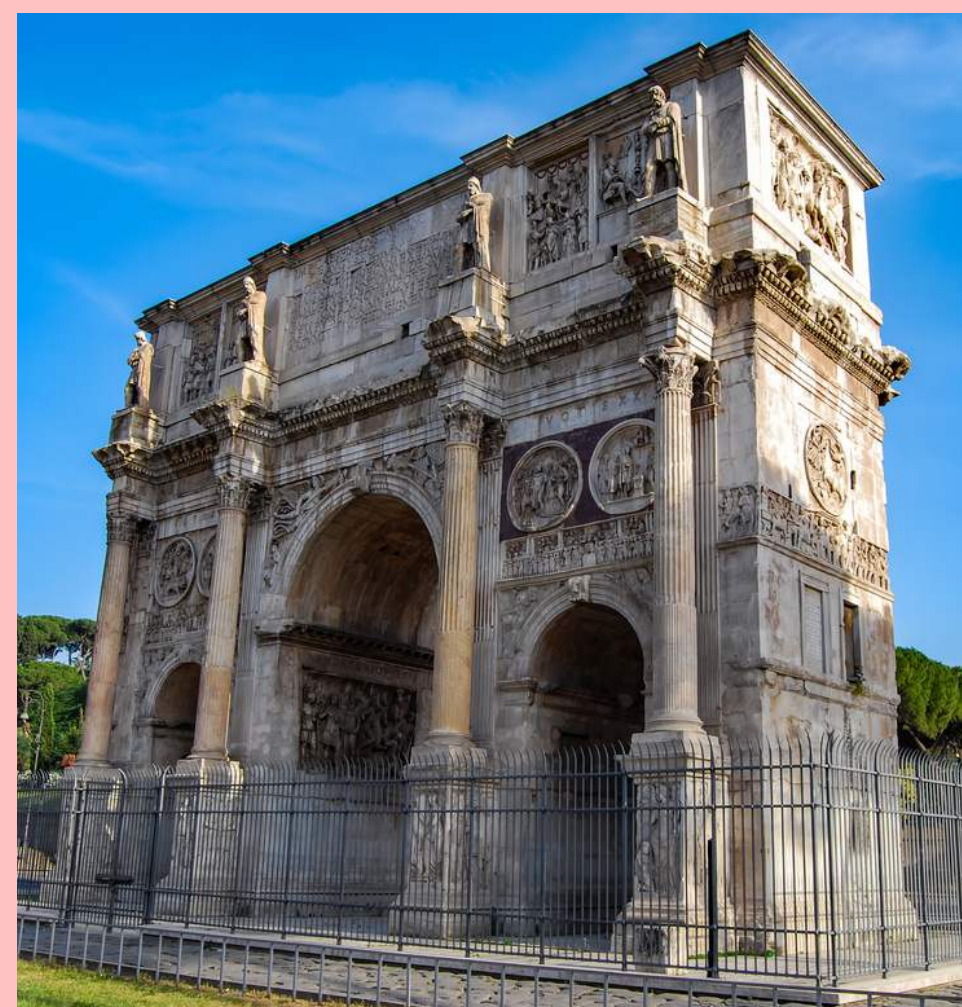
Welcome to **Rome**! Upon your arrival, we'll be there to transfer you to your hotel. Later, our guide will meet you and provide all the essential information. You can also find details on the information sign in the hotel reception area. In the evening, we'll take you to **Via Cavour**, an excellent introduction to Rome. Here, you'll find a variety of restaurants offering Italian, Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine.

DAY 02 : ROME



- Panoramic tour of the Eternal City, combining walking and panoramic bus ride
- Photostops: The Arch of Constantine, Colosseum, and Imperial Forums
- Bus tour of the open-air museum city, passing by the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and the exterior of Castel Sant'Angelo
- Walk through Trastevere's narrow cobblestone streets.

The morning tour will take you through Italy's capital, the Eternal City, a historic and influential city. The walking tour will take you to the exterior of **Arch of Constantine**, the **Colosseum**, and the **Imperial Forums**. The tour will then continue by bus, exploring the open-air museum city with its basilicas and churches. The tour will end at **Vatican City**, an independent state within Rome and the center of the Catholic Church. The afternoon is free to visit the **Sistine Chapel** and the **Vatican Museums**. In the evening, make your way to **Trastevere**, a charming district with hidden gems like medieval churches, quirky shops, and authentic local dishes. The area also offers restaurants serving Indian, Chinese, and international cuisine. The tour concludes at the hotel.



DAY 03 : ROME - FLORENCE



- Traveling from Rome to Florence
- Departure north, enjoying stunning landscapes.
- Arrival at Piazzale Michelangelo for stunning city views.
- Guided walking tour through historic center, visiting landmarks like Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. (outside views)
- Free time for exploration and dinner at various international restaurants in the district.

Today, we'll leave **Rome** and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning **Piazzale Michelangelo** for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the **Ponte Vecchio**, the **Duomo**, and **Piazza della Signoria**. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.





DAY 04 : FLORENCE - VENICE

 B

- Cross the Apennines to admire stunning mountain landscapes
- Take a boat across the Giudecca Canal to Venice Island
- Visit St. Mark's Square
- Tour the Murano Glass Factory to learn ancient glass techniques
- Accommodation in Mestre district

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the **Apennines**. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a boat across the **Giudecca Canal** to the **Island of Venice**. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous **St. Mark's Square**. Afterwards, we'll tour the **Murano Glass Factory**, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district. (Optional Gondola Ride at EUR 40/ pax).



DAY 05 : VENICE - INNSBRUCK - SALZBURG

 B

- Depart Venice for Austria & journey through Austrian Alps scenery
- Visit Innsbruck's historic center and enjoy lunch
- Scenic drive to Kitzbühel, a famous ski village
- Continues to Salzburg, arriving by evening

We will depart from Venice, traveling to **Austria!** Upon arriving in **Innsbruck**, you'll have time to stroll through the historic city center and enjoy lunch in the **Austrian Tyrolean** capital. Afterward, we'll journey along beautiful scenic roads through the mountains to **Kitzbühel**. Once there, you'll have time to explore this picturesque village, a famous ski resort where snow can be enjoyed for most of the year. We'll continue our journey to **Salzburg**, arriving by the end of the day.

Note: If there are few travelers, we may take a train from Venice to Innsbruck.



DAY 06 : SALZBURG - LAKE TRAUNSEE - VIENNA

 B

- Morning tour of Salzburg, Mozart's picturesque hometown
- Scenic drive through lakes and mountains to St. Wolfgang
- Visit Traunkirchen by Traunsee Lake
- Enjoy a cruise to view four castles on the lake
- Disembark in Gmunden and continue to Vienna, arriving in the evening

Today, we'll get to know Austria better. During the morning, we'll explore **Salzburg**, Mozart's city. Its Renaissance and Baroque center is filled with beauty, all in the shadow of the grand castle. Next, we'll travel through lakes and mountains to reach **St. Wolfgang**, a renowned pilgrimage site in Austria. We'll then head to **Traunkirchen**, located beside the beautiful **Traunsee Lake**, where we'll take a cruise (included) to see four of the lake's castles before disembarking in **Gmunden**. Afterward, we'll continue to **Vienna**, arriving in the evening.



DAY 07 : VIENNA

 B

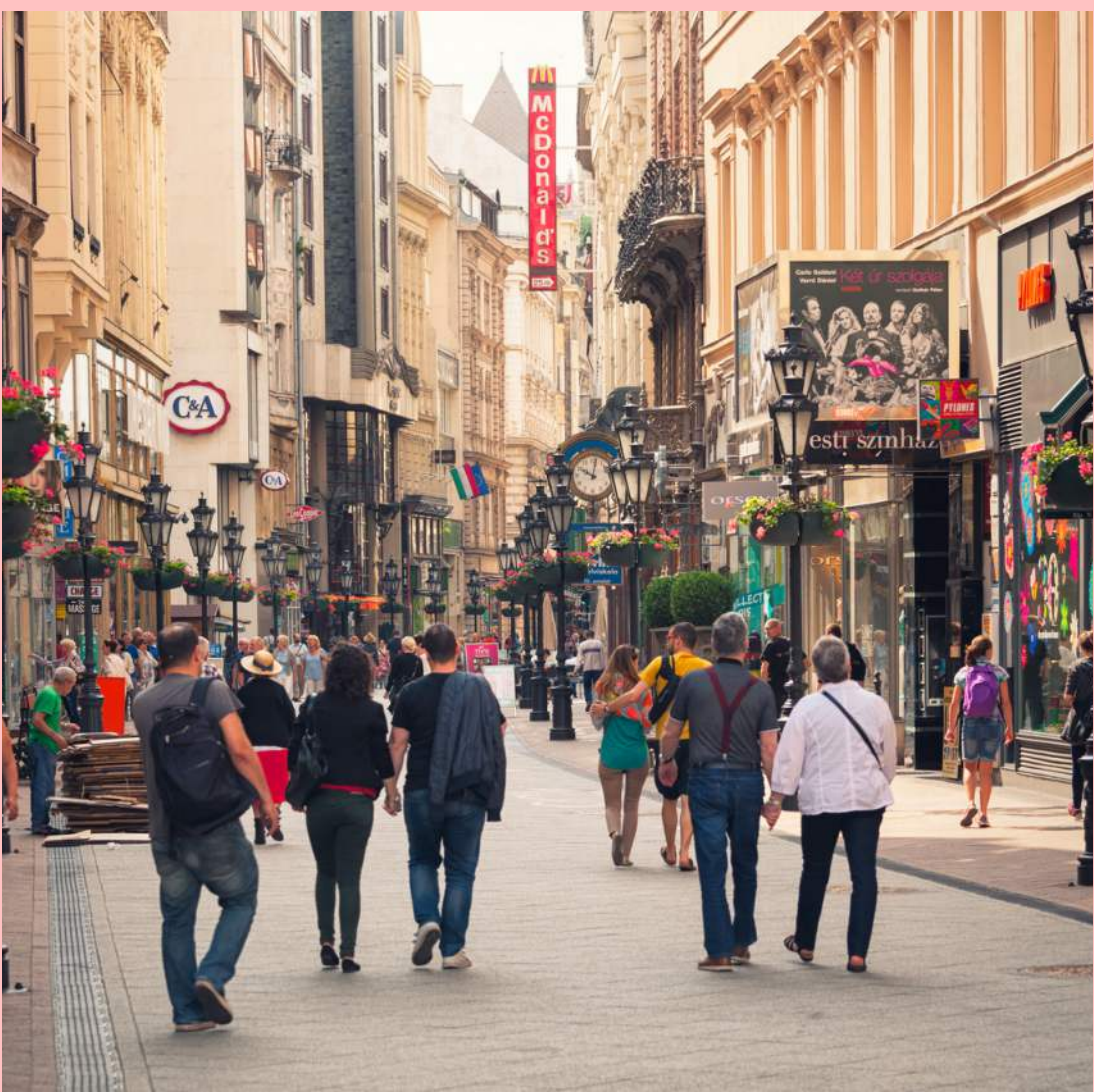
- Panoramic tour of Vienna with a local guide
- Free time in the afternoon to explore independently
- Evening visit to Grinzing wine village

Today, we'll embark on a **panoramic tour** of this impressive city with a local guide. We'll explore its majestic avenues, beautiful palaces, large parks and vibrant city center. In the afternoon, you'll have free time to explore on your own. In the evening, we'll include a transfer to the **Grinzing district**, an old wine-growing village now part of the city, known for its traditional taverns. You'll have free time to dine in the area.

DAY 08: VIENNA - BUDAPEST

 B

- Travel to Budapest, Hungary’s capital
 - Enjoy a boat trip on the Danube River with views of Buda and Pest
 - Panoramic city tour of the "Queen of the Danube"
 - Afternoon free time to spend in city center
 - Optional evening outing to a Magyar show with dinner included
- After about three hours of travel, we’ll arrive in **Budapest**, the capital of Hungary. Our first stop will be the lively area of **Váci utca**, where you’ll have free time for lunch. After, we’ll kick off our exploration of Budapest with an included boat trip on the **Danube River**, with historic Buda on one bank and cosmopolitan Pest on the other. The views are unbeatable. Following this, we’ll begin a **panoramic tour** of the so-called "**Queen of the Danube.**" You’ll have some free time afterwards. In the evening, we’ll offer an optional outing to a Magyar show, with dinner included.



DAY 09: BUDAPEST - BRATISLAVA - PRAGUE

 B

- Depart Budapest early and travel to Bratislava, Slovakia
 - Continue to the Czech Republic, arriving in Prague
 - Evening transfer to Old Town Square for sightseeing and dinner
- We will leave Budapest early and head for **Bratislava**, the capital of Slovakia, a charming city along the Danube with an attractive historic center. You’ll have time to explore and enjoy lunch. After, we’ll continue our journey to the **Czech Republic**, arriving in **Prague** in the evening. We’ll provide a transfer to the **Old Town Square**, a central spot that offers a fantastic introduction to Prague with its vibrant atmosphere and numerous tourist activities. You can have dinner at one of the many restaurants offering a variety of international cuisines, including Czech, Chinese, Indian, and Italian. Afterward, we’ll return to the hotel.



DAY 10 : PRAGUE

 B

- Guided panoramic tour of Prague, the Baroque jewel of Europe
 - Visit to Prague Castle (admission included)
 - Enjoy a boat ride on the Vltava River
 - Afternoon free time to spend in city center
- Today, we’ll visit the capital, **Prague**, the Baroque jewel of Europe. Our local tour guide will lead an **informative panoramic tour**, highlighting the city’s most outstanding monuments. During the tour, there will be a visit to **Prague Castle** (admission included). After that, enjoy a **boat ride on the Vltava River** (included). In the afternoon, you’ll have free time to explore the city on your own.



DAY 11 : PRAGUE - PILSEN - ROTHENBURG - FRANKFURT

 B

- Depart Prague and visit Pilsen, famous for its beer
 - Explore Pilsen’s historic center: Old Town Square, cathedral, and Renaissance town hall (photo-stops)
 - Cross into Germany and travel along part of the Romantic Road
 - Visit the fairy-tale town of Rothenburg
- We’ll depart early from Prague and stop in **Pilsen**, in western Bohemia, a city renowned for its beer. You’ll have time to stroll through its historic center, where you’ll find the **Old Town Square**, the **cathedral**, the **Plague Column**, and a **Renaissance-era town hall**. We’ll then cross into Germany and follow part of the **Romantic Road**. We’ll visit **Rothenburg**, a town that seems to come straight out of a fairy tale and is considered one of the most beautiful villages in the country. Afterward, we’ll head to **Frankfurt**, the financial capital of Germany. After our arrival in the evening, enjoy free time in the historic city center, where you’ll find a wide variety of restaurants offering Indian, Asian, Italian, and international cuisines.





DAY 12 : FRANKFURT - CRUISE ON THE RHINE - COLOGNE - AMSTERDAM B

- Travel to Budapest, Hungary's capital
- Enjoy a boat trip on the Danube River with views of Buda and Pest
- Panoramic city tour of the "Queen of the Danube"
- Afternoon free time to spend in city center

Today, we'll take a **scenic cruise on the Rhine** between the villages of **Rüdesheim** and **St. Goar**, the river's most picturesque section. After that, we'll travel to **Cologne**, known for its immense **Gothic cathedral**. Then, we'll head to **Holland**, arriving in **Amsterdam** in the evening.

DAY 13 : AMSTERDAM B

Today, we'll be visiting some very picturesque spots, the Holland of our dreams. We'll start by visiting **Zaanse Schans**, known for its windmills, canals, and houses. Next, we'll explore **Volendam**, a picturesque fishing village. A **short boat ride** from Volendam will take us to **Marken**, an island connected to the mainland by a dike, where the houses are built on stilts. Afterward, we'll head to **Amsterdam** for a **panoramic tour** of the city, including its narrow canals, official buildings, and parks. We'll also see a **diamond-cutting demonstration**. At the end of the day, we'll provide a transfer to the lively city center, an area with many restaurants to choose from.

DAY 14 : AMSTERDAM DEPART TO KUALA LUMPUR B

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard check-out policy, our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful lasting memories. Transfer included to airport for flight back home.
