### DAY 1 : CHECK IN/DEPARTURE KUALA LUMPUR ✈️

### DAY 2 : ARRIVAL ROME

- Welcome to Europe, Transfer from airport to hotel

Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to **transfer** you to your hotel. free at own leisure. In the afternoon, you'll find information about the start of your tour on the boards located at the hotel reception.

### DAY 3 : ROME

🍽️ B

- Discover Rome's timeless charm with a panoramic and walking tour showcasing iconic sites like the Colosseum. (Photo stops)
- Photo stop at Imperial Forums, and Vatican City. Lunch at Vatican square area on own
- Optional: Entrance to Vatican, Sistine Chapel EUR70/pax & follow by Rome Old City walking tour EUR40/pax.
- Afternoon free at own leisure or join optional, those pax not joining the optional please make your way to Trastevere area in evening to meet the group again, enjoying its quaint streets, vibrant trattorias to have dinner on own. Back to hotel with guide.

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial **Rome** with a **panoramic bus ride** to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant'Angelo.

The tour will end at **Vatican City** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. At the end of the day, make your way **to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.

### DAY 4 : ROME

Enjoy a free day to take in the charm of this city, exploring and discovering its memorable places.

### DAY 5 : ROME - FLORENCE

🍽️ B

- Florence walking tour with a local expert in the historic centre

We'll journey to Florence, the capital of Tuscany. Upon arrival, we'll stop at the Michelangelo viewpoint for a photo opportunity, offering one of the most stunning views of the city. Following this, we'll embark on a **sightseeing tour with a local guide** of this renowned city, one of Italy's most visited destinations considered the cradle of the Renaissance and some of the most influential artists and thinkers in history, such as Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Botticelli, and Raphael.

Highlights of the tour (Photostops) at Gothic cathedral Duomo di Firenze, the historic Ponte Vecchio, known for its goldsmith workshops along its paved streets and Piazza della Signoria, the city's political heart featuring the medieval town hall. The rest of the afternoon will be free.

**Note:** We recommend wearing comfortable shoes for the visit to Florence.





## DAY 6 : FLORENCE - PISA - CINQUE TERRE - GENOA

B

- Explore on little tourist train Pisa, Piazza Dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles)
- Train to Cinque Terre, the famous picturesque Villages

Today, we'll travel to **Pisa**. A **little tourist train** will take us to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), home of the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa (Photostop). After this, we'll head to the Ligurian Riviera, renowned for some of the prettiest coastlines in Europe. We'll visit the **Cinque Terre**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This area comprises five villages, almost isolated by road, which live on tourism. We'll arrive by **train**, tickets included, to one of its charming towns (normally **Vernazza**, but on busy tourist dates, it could be Manarola or Corniglia, very similar towns that are somewhat less crowded). We'll have time for lunch. Afterwards, we'll travel by train to **Levanto**, where we'll take the bus to continue to **Genoa**. Its center reminds us that it was a thriving republic in the Middle Ages.

**Note:** The train to Cinque Terre is a regular commuter service, not a tourist train. During peak tourism times, there can be long waits as trains may be full, and seat reservations are not available. In some cases, the journey might be done standing.

## DAY 7: GENOA - PORTOFINO - MILAN

B

- Exploring Rapallo and Portofino's Coastal Charm
- From Seaside Strolls to Milan's bustling city

We'll continue our journey to the nearby city of Rapallo, where we'll embark for Portofino, one of the most exclusive places in Europe. Enjoy a stroll by the sea and time at leisure. After lunch, we'll continue to Milan, where you'll have free time to stroll through this elegant city—now a symbol of modernity and culture in northern Italy. We recommend visiting its stunning Gothic cathedral in Piazza del Duomo, as well as the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, built in honor of the first king of a unified Italy.

**Additional note:** Due to adverse weather conditions or during winter, the boat crossing to Portofino (whether from Rapallo or Santa Margherita) may not be operational due to weather conditions.

## DAY 8: MILAN - LAKES REGION - VERONA

B

- Discovering the Scenic Italian Lakes: Orta, Maggiore, and Isola Bella
- From Medieval Charm to Verdant Gardens and a Journey to Verona

Today we'll see one of the most beautiful scenic areas in Europe, the region of the **Italian Lakes**. First, we'll travel to **Lake Orta** in **Orta San Giulio**, a well-preserved medieval city. We'll take a train ride to reach the medieval center of the town and then a boat to the **Island of San Giulio**, a little island on the lake with a monastery. After this, we'll go on to **Lake Maggiore**, making a stop in **Stresa**, where we'll have the option to visit the Borromean Islands. The highlight is **Isola Bella**, featuring its gardens and palace (closed in the winter). We'll have some time for lunch and then we'll head to **Verona**.

**Note:** During the winter months, the Orta train does not operate. If that is the case, you can access the medieval town by walking approximately 800 meters from the bus parking lot.

## DAY 9 : VERONA - VENICE

B

- Romantic Verona to Venice: A Journey Through History and Canals
- Exploring Venice: St. Mark's, Murano Glass
- Gondola ride is optional EUR40/pax

We'll have time to explore **Verona**, the enchanting city of Romeo and Juliet, before departing for **Venice**, arriving around 01:00 p.m. A delightful **boat trip** to St. Mark's Square is included, followed by a **guided walking tour** of the City of Canals, including a visit to see Murano glasswork. Afterwards, enjoy some leisure time—perhaps a gondola ride? Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.

## DAY 10 : VENICE

B

After breakfast, check-out hotel as per standard hotel's policy. Free at own leisure till transfer provided to airport.
