DAY 1 : CHECK IN /DEPART KLIA ✈️ LONDON

- Arrival London, pickup from airport and transfer to Hotel

Welcome to **London** Upon arriving at the airport, we will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts next day

DAY 2 : LONDON



- Explore London with a city tour covering Westminster, Parliament, and the Thames. (Photo stop)
- Enjoy free time with an optional visit to Windsor Castle.
- End the day with a lively walk through Piccadilly, Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho.

In the morning, we'll go on a **city tour of London**, visiting Westminster, the Parliament, the City, and the Thames. In the afternoon, you'll have free time, during which we'll offer an optional visit to the Thames Valley, including the town of Windsor, crowned by the stunning Windsor Castle. In the evening, we'll meet at Piccadilly for a **walk through Leicester Square, Chinatown, and Soho**, known for its vibrant atmosphere, theaters, and entertainment (in some cases, this evening program might be organized for the previous day, upon arrival in London). Afterward, we'll return to the hotel by bus.



DAY 3 : LONDON



- Free day

Enjoy a free day to take in the charm of this city, exploring and discovering its memorable places

DAY 4 : LONDON - CALAIS - AMIENS - PARIS



- Journey from London to France via ferry, with stops in Calais and Amiens to admire its Gothic cathedral.
- Explore floating gardens, and Jules Verne's home (Photo stop), before arriving in Paris by evening.

We'll depart from **London** and make our way to the continent, taking a **ferry to France**. After a technical stop in Calais, we'll continue to **Amiens**, known for its Gothic cathedral. Here, you can wander through the lively narrow streets, explore the floating gardens, and visit the house where Jules Verne once lived. We'll then head to **Paris**, arriving by the end of the day.



DAY 5 : PARIS



- Explore the grandeur of the Palace of Versailles (Admission not included).
- Visit Montmartre's artistic charming, and iconic Paris landmarks on a guided city tour, with an optional evening variety show.

We'll immerse ourselves in the rich history of **France** at the magnificent Palace of Versailles (admission not included), renowned for its stunning gardens. On our return to **Paris**, we'll visit **Montmartre**, where a charming bohemian neighborhood famous for its artists, painters, and cabarets. To fully appreciate the grandeur of **Paris**, we'll embark on a **panoramic city tour** with a local guide, showcasing the city's impressive avenues and iconic monuments. Afterward, we'll return to the hotel. For those interested, there is an optional variety show in the evening.



DAY 6 : PARIS

- Visit the Eiffel Tower with access to the second floor.
- Enjoy a scenic Seine River cruise, and spend the afternoon exploring Paris at your leisure.

We'll start our day in central **Paris**, beginning with a visit to the iconic **Eiffel Tower**. You'll have the chance to go up to the second floor of this famous iron landmark (tickets included). Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing **boat cruise along the Seine**, which will last approximately one hour and fifteen minutes. You'll have a free afternoon to explore the city at your own pace. Back to hotel on own expenses by taking Uber

Note: If wait times at the Eiffel Tower are too long, we might reschedule the visit to a different time (or on Sunday) for your convenience.

DAY 7 : PARIS - BURGUNDY - BEAUNE - LYON

- Discover Beaune's charming streets and rich wine heritage.
- Explore Lyon's historic UNESCO World Heritage center (Photo stop), capped with panoramic views from Notre-Dame de Fourvière.

Today, we'll journey to the heart of **France**, passing through the **Bourgogne** region, renowned for its picturesque vineyards and world-class wines. Our first stop will be **Beaune**, a charming town in the center of Burgundy known for its flower-filled streets, hospice, and wine museum. After some free time for lunch and a walk, we'll continue to Lyon, the former capital of Roman Gaul, located on the banks of the Rhône River. Lyon's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage site. We'll take a **cable car up to Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, where we can enjoy a stunning view of the city. You'll have some free time to explore at your leisure.

Note: In some cases, part of the group will stay in Chambéry, a city near Lyon. In these instances, we'll travel to Chambéry in the evening for an overnight stay. In the morning, you'll have time to visit this medieval-style city, the capital de la Savoie, known for its beautiful historic center and impressive castle.

DAY 8 : LYON - GENEVA - ZURICH

- Explore Geneva's Palace of Nations, English Garden, and iconic Jet d'Eau. (Photo stop)
- Enjoy scenic drives through the Three Lakes region.
- Visiting Neuchâtel's historic center and lake, before arriving in Zurich.

Today, we'll travel to **Switzerland**. Upon arrival in **Geneva**, we'll pass by the Palace of Nations (the European headquarters of the United Nations) and explore the pretty English Garden with its flower clock and admire the Jet d'Eau, the tallest fountain in Europe. After lunch, we'll continue our journey through Switzerland, traveling along the scenic routes by **Lake Geneva** and **Lake Neuchâtel**. We'll drive along the Three Lakes region, enjoying views of magnificent vineyards set against the mountain backdrop. We'll stop in **Neuchâtel**, where you can enjoy a walk by the lake, explore the historic town center, or visit the beautiful 10th-century castle. Our journey will conclude in **Zurich**, where we'll arrive in the late afternoon.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers traveling from Geneva to Zurich, this part of the trip may be done by train, in which case there will be no stop in Neuchâtel.

DAY 9 : ZURICH

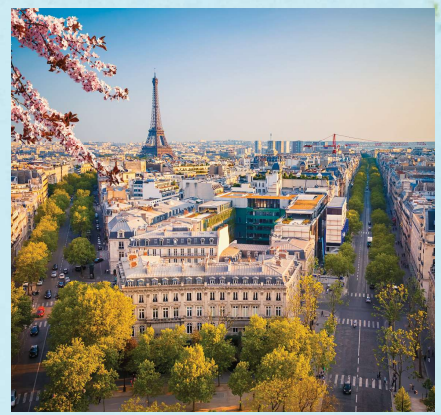


B

- Discover Zurich's vibrant culture and history.
- Enjoy a scenic Lake Zurich cruise with stops in charming villages.
- Visit Rapperswil's medieval castle, and return to Zurich via Switzerland's efficient railway system.

With our guide, we'll explore **Zurich**, the most populous city in **Switzerland**, and its financial and cultural heart. Known for its banks, Zurich has been twice recognized as the city with the best quality of life in the world. Afterwards, we'll embark on a scenic **cruise** of nearly two hours on **Lake Zurich**, with brief stops to enjoy the charming villages along the route. We'll disembark in **Rapperswil**, a picturesque village renowned for its medieval castle. We'll return to Zurich by **train**, providing an opportunity to experience the efficiency and punctuality of the Swiss railway system.

Note: Depending on the number of travelers, transfers to and from the city center may be via local transport.





DAY 10 : ZURICH - LUCERNE - ZURICH

 B/L

- Explore Grindelwald and enjoy breathtaking views from a cable car ride and suspended bridge, followed by lunch on the mountain.
- Continue to Lucerne, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, before returning to Zurich.

Today's journey features stunning landscapes with tall mountains and pristine lakes. We'll enjoy breathtaking scenery in the **Interlaken** region. Our first stop will be **Grindelwald**, where we'll have time for a coffee before taking the cable car up the mountain. Once there, we'll walk along a winding path leading to a suspended bridge. For those who are adventurous, crossing the bridge offers spectacular views of the surrounding glaciers. We'll have **lunch on the mountain** (included) before heading back down. Our next destination is **Lucerne**, one of Switzerland's most beautiful cities, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy the charming cityscape. We'll then return to **Zurich**.

Note: The guide will offer an optional full-day excursion, starting in the morning. After some free time in Lucerne, we'll take a rotating cable car to the summit of Mount Titlis. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the alpine summit offers breathtaking views of the glacier and the Alps.



DAY 11 : ZURICH - BELLINZONA - COMO - MILAN

- Visit Bellinzona known for UNESCO-listed medieval castles (Photo stop).
- Explore Como's lakeside gardens and cathedral, then head to Milan to see the iconic Piazza del Duomo (Photostop) before transferring to the hotel.

We'll leave **Zurich** early in the morning, crossing the Alps to reach the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Our first stop will be **Bellinzona**, renowned for its three medieval castles, which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Perched on the hills overlooking the city, these castles highlight Bellinzona's historical significance as a key alpine stronghold. Enjoy some free time to wander through the charming streets of the center. Next, we'll enter Italy and stop in the charming town of **Como** for lunch. This town is considered the jewel of **Lombardy**, known for its beautiful gardens beside the lake and its spectacular cathedral. We'll continue to **Milan**, where our guide will take us to the impressive Piazza del Duomo. You'll have some time to wander around before we transfer you to the hotel.



DAY 12 : MILAN - PISA - ROME

 B

- Visit Pisa's Piazza dei Miracoli (Photo stop).
- The Leaning Tower of Pisa before continuing to Rome.

Today, we'll continue our journey to **Pisa**. We'll ride a small **tourist train** to the Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles), where you'll have time to admire one of the most captivating and beautiful art complexes in **Italy**, including the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Afterwards, we'll head to **Rome**, arriving later in the day.



DAY 13 : ROME

 B

- Morning Bus City tour of Eternal City
- See Arch of Constantine, Colosseum (from the outside), Imperial Forums, Circus
- Maximus, Baths of Caracalla, Basilica of Saint Mary Major, Pyramid of Cestius,
- and Castel Sant' Angelo (Photo Stop)
- Optional visit to Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel
- Evening transfer to Trastevere neighborhood for dinner and leisure

In the morning, we'll take a **three-hour guided tour** of the Eternal City, combining a walking tour through Imperial Rome with a panoramic bus ride to admire one of the oldest and most influential cities in Western civilization. During the tour, we'll see iconic landmarks such as the Arch of Constantine, the exterior of the Colosseum (**from the outside**) and the Imperial Forums, the Circus Maximus, the Baths of Caracalla, the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, the Pyramid of Cestius, and Castel Sant' Angelo.

The tour will end at **VATICAN CITY** around 11:00 a.m. Afterward, our guide will offer an optional visit to explore the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel.

At the end of the day, we'll include a **transfer to the popular Trastevere neighborhood**, known for its cozy restaurants and lively atmosphere. Return to the hotel will be around 8:30 p.m.





DAY 14 : ROME - FLORENCE

🏠 B

- Depart Rome, head north to Florence, photostop Piazzale Michelangelo
- Evening tour of historic center with local expert,
- Visit Ponte Vecchio, Duomo, Plaza della Signoria (Photo stop).

Today, we'll leave Rome and head north, taking in the beautiful landscapes along the way. Upon reaching **Florence**, we'll go directly to the stunning Piazzale Michelangelo for breathtaking views of the city. In the evening, we'll enjoy a **guided walking tour** with a local expert through the historic center, visiting landmarks such as the Ponte Vecchio, the Duomo, and Piazza della Signoria. This city is like an open-air museum. Afterward, you'll have some free time to explore at your leisure. In the evening, you'll have plenty of options for dinner, as this district offers many restaurants with a variety of international cuisines.



DAY 15 : FLORENCE - VENICE

🏠 B

- Traverse Apennine Mountains, arrive in Venice by water taxi, cross to island
- Explore St. Mark's Square with guide.
- Visit Murano Glass Factory
- Gondola Ride Optional EUR40/pax

Today, we'll enjoy the stunning mountain landscapes as we cross the Apennines. Upon arriving in **Venice**, we'll take a **boat across the Giudecca Canal** to the Island of Venice. With a local guide, we'll visit the marvelous St. Mark's Square. Afterwards, we'll tour the Murano Glass Factory, where you'll see the fascinating techniques used to create this ancient glass. You'll have some free time to explore on your own. Accommodation will be in the Mestre district.



DAY 16 : VENICE ✈️ KUALA LUMPUR

After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.

DAY 17 : ARRIVAL KLIA

Arrival KLIA. Welcome back home!
