DAY 3 : BERLIN



- City tour of Berlin
- Holocaust Memorial
- Berlin Wall Museum, afternoon some free time

Immerse yourself in the local culture with a guided **panoramic tour of Berlin**, the captivating capital of **Germany**. We'll see the historic center, Museum Island, the Reichstag, the Brandenburg Gate, the shopping streets and the city's beautiful parks. Our visit will also include stops at the **Holocaust Memorial** and the **Berlin Wall Memorial Museum**. For an optional excursion, you can visit Potsdam and its stunning palaces.

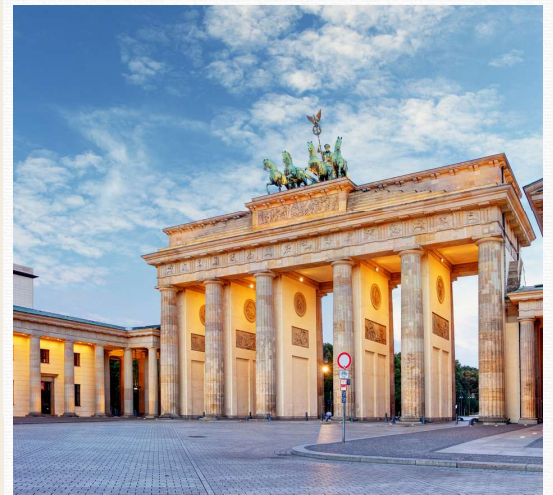


DAY 4 : BERLIN - DRESDEN - BAMBERG - NUREMBERG



- Bavarian Republic of Germany

We will travel to **DRESDEN**, a city on the river Elba where we can admire its palace. We go on to Bavaria and our arrival in **BAMBERG**, a very beautiful city full of life; don't miss little Venice! We continue to **NUREMBERG**, the second largest city in Bavaria, and a city of great history where we suggest a visit to the place where Hitler's Coliseum stood.



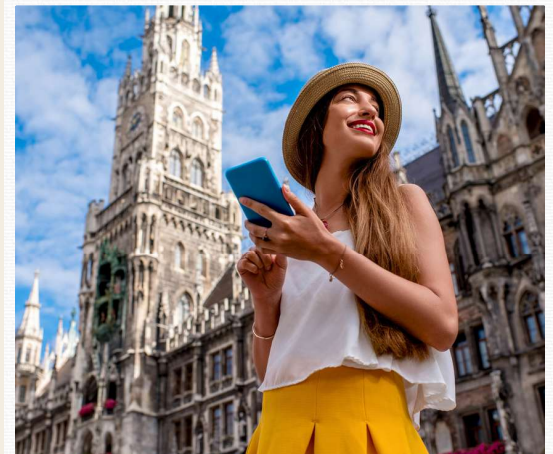
DAY 5 : NUREMBERG - KLOSTER - WELTENBURG - DACHAU - MUNICH



- Cruise on the Danube River
- Beautiful landscapes along the Journey
- Dachau concentration camp & BMW world

Today's journey will be full of surprises. From Kelheim, we'll board a **boat for a short cruise along the Danube valley**, passing through the Danube Gorge. Our first stop will be Kloster Weltenburg, a beautiful Benedictine monastery founded in 1040. Next, we'll visit **DACHAU**, where we'll tour the Nazi concentration camp museum. After having lunch, we'll continue to **MUNICH**, where we'll visit the impressive BMW Welt, a modern multifunctional exhibition facility of the prestigious German vehicle brand BMW Group. We'll also see the park that houses the Olympiastadion, an architectural marvel where the 1972 Olympic Games were held. After this, you'll have free time in the historic center. You can stroll through Marienplatz, the heart of Munich, visit the picturesque Viktualienmarkt open-air market, relax in the Englischer Garten, or enjoy the traditional beer houses.

Note: In winter or when Danube's water level is too low, the cruise will not operate. In this case, this section of the circuit will be adapted so we can stop to visit Landshut. Kloster Wetelbug will also be closed in winter, but you will still be able to see it from the outside.





DAY 6 : MUNICH - FUSSEN - ROTHENBURG - FRANKFURT



- Neuschwanstein Castle
- Maria Bridge admire the fantastic scenery from this little bridge between the hills.
- Travel to Rothenburg and enter the beautiful Christmas Museum (entrance included)

Amidst alpine summits and very beautiful scenery, we travel to **FUSSEN** and the **Neuschwanstein Castle**. We get on a bus to Maria Bridge and admire the fantastic scenery from this little bridge between the hills. You can either return on foot or horse and cart (not included). After this, continuing with our romantic route, we travel to **ROTHENBURG**, a very pretty city surrounded by walls, where we enter the beautiful **Christmas Museum (entrance included)**. Next **FRANKFURT**, Germany's financial capital. Arrival in the evening.

DAY 7 : FRANKFURT - CRUISE ON THE RIVER RHINE - COLOGNE- DORTMUND



- Cruise on the scenic Rhine River between Rudesheim and St. Goar, then lunch in Cochem with views of its ancient castle.
- Visit Cologne's iconic Gothic cathedral and explore the lively city center before heading to Dortmund for the night.

Today we will see the valleys of the Rhine and Mosel, two rivers loaded with history and sprinkled with charming villages. We take a short **cruise on the Rhine**, between the villages of **RUDESHEIM** and **Sankt Goar**, undoubtedly the most picturesque section of the river. Then we will go on to the river Mosel, and will have time for lunch in **COCHEM**, a very picturesque village on the bank of the river, dominated by its imposing castle, whose origin dates back more than a thousand years. After that we travel to **COLOGNE**. Time to visit its impressive Gothic cathedral, which with its 154 metres of height was the tallest building in the world until the end of the 19th century. You can also have a walk along the Rhine River and through the lively city center before going on to our hotel in **DORTMUND**. **Note:** During fairs or congresses, accommodation may be in a nearby city.

DAY 8 : DORTMUND - FAIRY TALE ROUTE - HANNOVER



- Explore Trendelburg's medieval castle, iconic Rapunzel Tower, journey through picturesque landscapes reminiscent of fairytales.
- Discover Hoxter's lively town center and Corvey Abbey, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before photographing the ruins of "Cinderella's" castle in Polle, and immersing yourself in the folklore of "The Pied Piper of Hamelin" in Hamelin.

Today we will have a stage full of magic, reminding us about the stories and movies from our childhood, as we travel through towns that inspired the Brothers Grimm and that is called today the **Fairytales Route**. We will travel to **TRENDELBURG**, a picturesque walled village dominated by its large medieval castle. We visit the castle with its **RAPUNZEL TOWER (entrance included)**. We continue along small roads, crossing forests while we imagine "Hansel and Gretel". Time for lunch in **HOXTER**, a small town full of life where **Corvey Abbey** is located, an ancient monastery from the 9th century, a World Heritage Site (a stop to photograph its walls and interior patios). We continue our route making a brief stop in **POLLE** to photograph the exterior ruins of "**Cinderella's**" castle. We continue to **HAMELIN**, a city popular for the story of "The Pied Piper of Hamelin". After enjoying following the mouse tracks we continue to **HANNOVER** with some time to get to know the center of this thriving city and a walk next to the old town hall. **Note:** During fairs or conferences, accommodation may be arranged in a nearby city. Corvey Abbey is closed from November to February.

DAY 9 : HANNOVER - HAMBURG - FLENSBURG - AARHUS



- North of Germany and farming regions of Jutland

After breakfast, we leave Hannover for **HAMBURG**, where we go around its lake and see its busy port full of life, time for lunch. After lunch we travel to **FLENSBURG** a pretty seaside village with its marina on the border with Denmark. Our route goes on to **AARHUS**, Denmark's second largest city in the center of Jutland.



DAY 10 : AARHUS - KRISTIANSAND FERRY- KRISTIANSAND - STAVANGER B

- Embark on a ferry journey from Hirtshals to Kristiansand, enjoying a scenic three-hour voyage across the North Sea.
- Explore Norway's southern coastline, with stops in picturesque towns like Flekkefjord, known for its wooden houses and fjord views, before arriving in Stavanger, a charming port town nestled by the fjord.

We will travel to **HIRTSHALS**, where we will take a **ferry** crossing the North Sea **to Norway**. A three-hour voyage to **KRISTIANSAND**. We will continue along Norway's southern coastline and enjoy its stunning landscapes. Next stop in **FLEKKEFJORD**, a town with its wooden houses and tiny restaurants on a fjord. Arrival to **STAVANGER**, a small picturesque town that has an active port by the fjord. **Note:** Ferry operation hours vary depending on the months. Normally you will have time to have lunch on the boat.

DAY 11 : STAVANGER - BERGEN B

- Stop at the 'Swords in Rock' monument
- Take a cable car to Mount Fløyen for panoramic views of Bergen and the fjord, with leisure time to explore the city.

Upon leaving the city, we will stop at the 'Swords in Rock' monument, where we will be reminded of the Vikings, before continuing the very beautiful scenic tour. We follow the route going through tunnels, bridges and travel some stretches by boat to go along the **fjord coast of Norway**. One of its undersea tunnels is the deepest one in the world. This stage gets more relaxed and spectacular with its two boat trips. We will arrive in **BERGEN** at lunch time. We take a **cable car trip to Mount Fløyen** which offers amazing views of the town and Bergen fjord. There will be some leisure time later to enjoy the capital city of fjords.

DAY 12 : BERGEN - SOGNE FJORD - OSLO B

- Fjord cruise Gudvangen-Aurland, Tvindefossen Waterfall stop, View Borgund Stave Church, Drive through Aurland Tunnel, Arrive Oslo, free time in city center

Today, we'll experience more breathtaking landscapes, including Norway's fjords, glaciers, lakes, and forests. Our journey will take us to **SOGNEFJORD**, the largest fjord in Norway. Along the way, we'll stop at the stunning **TVINDEFOSSEN WATERFALL**. Then, we'll embark on a magnificent cruise between **GUDVANGEN** and **AURLAND**, enjoying the stunning scenery during this hour-and-a-half voyage. We suggest having lunch on board. Continuing our adventure, we'll traverse magnificent snow-covered landscapes and pass through the Aurland Tunnel, the longest in the world. We'll make a brief stop to admire the exterior of Borgund Stave Church, considered the best-preserved medieval wooden church in Norway. Finally, we'll arrive in **OSLO** with free time to explore the port, main streets, and the artwork in Frogner Park.

DAY 13 : OSLO B

- Sighseeing tour in Oslo.

In the morning, we'll take a **panoramic tour** of **OSLO**, the capital of **NORWAY**, beautifully set amidst stunning landscapes and known as Europe's green capital. With our local guide, we'll pass by the Royal Palace, stop at Vigeland Park with its impressive sculpture collection, and view the exterior of the Town Hall, the old port, and the new Opera House. After the tour, we suggest you visit one of the city's renowned museums, such as the Munch Museum. The afternoon will be yours to explore at leisure.

Our journey will come to an end, leaving you with wonderful and lasting memories.

Please, check the time of your flight in case you might need an additional night.

DAY 14 : OSLO KUALA LUMPUR

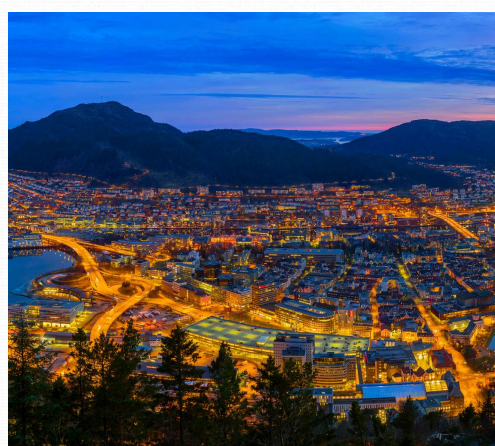
After breakfast, check-out as per hotel standard policy then free at own leisure till transfer to airport for flight back to Malaysia.
